Minutes of the Monthly Business Meeting, November 16, 2014

Attendees: Teleri, Patches, Rayhana, Emma, Graciela, Patricia, John West, Grazia, Griele, Johanna, William the Younger, Tirzah

Meeting commenced 7:11pm

Officers' Reports

Seneschal (Rayhana): Met with Lochmere (Gwen) about BotB for another 3 years. Lochmere will discuss, anticipate agreement. Will ask their people about a 3-day BotB. Has information on alternate site, will forward to Lochmere.

A&S (Johanna): No baronial A&S in December, ENEWG will go on Dec 9. Getting warrant renewed for another 2 years. Knitting will be happening at Silver Spring sewing night. People do not need to ask Johanna's permission to run A&S, just want to get names for her report.

Chatelaine (Emma): Emma's last report.

Newcomer's at Halloween at house. Many people came, including some from the demo.

12 newcomers. Game Night Nov 21 at Emma's house, low key for newcomer's. Office will now be turned over to Grazia (who agrees no point in scheduling anything in December). Patches says 4 newcomers have come to dancing.

<u>Chronicler</u> (Teleri): Newsletter. New feature called Vivat!, please submit accomplishments of barony members. Still need to reconcile officer lists with Webminister.

Exchequer (Tirzah): \$11,152.92 in the bank. Each barony earned \$1662.68 from BotB. Two small checks from BotB not yet cashed; Gracie says they are in now. St Andrews now \$850 per quarter, increase of \$50. Comfort Inn - price would go up \$18.50/meeting. Current contract up in March, could re-up now. Gracie investigating possible rates; alternate site in Silver Spring discussed later.

<u>Herald</u> (Patricia): Back from N Atlantian Heraldic commentary meeting. A few potential clients to get back to. Planning to go to Unevent - getting new Triton principle in January. Needs to renew warrant. Rose will consider being branch herald.

<u>Quartermaster</u> (John West): Two suits of loaner armor came back.

Webminister (Grazia): Nothing to report.

Baronage (Griele): Planning to attend Holiday Faire. Unevent is in December in the north. Let someone know if you can't get there. Discuss carpooling. Award recommendations sought in time for Storvik Song and Dance. Garb Wars in end of April, need teams - if interested let the baronage know. Making garb for Grazia and Johanna (last year's tourney captains). Performer's Revel wants to be April 18 which conflicts with Golden Rose, which baronage are committed to. Will check back with Fevronia to see if that's what she wants.

New Business

Possible new meeting room in Silver Spring for baronial business meetings: Johanna spoke with Magnus; they are willing to host the barony meeting at their site in Silver Spring, but they have to be there. Third Sunday in Jan-Feb are federal holidays, will not be there, but could do 2nd Sundays. \$0 rental fee. Parking garage behind their building, free after 7pm. Johanna encourages anyone to come to sewing on Thursday to check out the room.

Gracie points out free is great, having to rely on a single person to open the site is not so great.

How hard is it to switch reservations? It's commune rules, but whoever signs up first gets it. Uncertain how far in ahead reservations can be made, but it's empty most nights, and late Sunday isn't prime party time. They have board meetings in there when there's a 3-day weekend with Monday off. The site is 4 blocks from the Metro.

December Meeting: Rayhana on travel on December 21; proposes moving meeting to December 14. Patches (Autocrat for Song and Dance) cannot do the 14th. December meeting cancelled, January meeting moved to January 11. If Song and Dance needs an emergency meeting, one will be called.
