Baroness of Storvik,

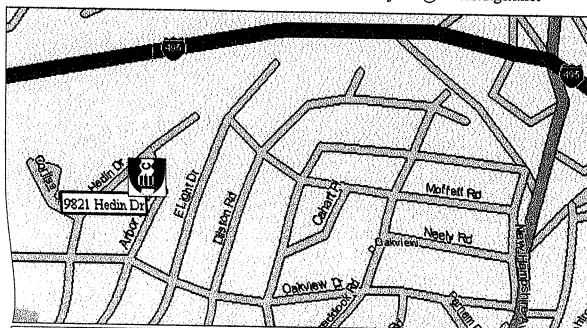

Speaking of successful endeavors, I ask all of you to consider those around you, and give me recommendations of those you consider worthy of recognition for their achievements and service.

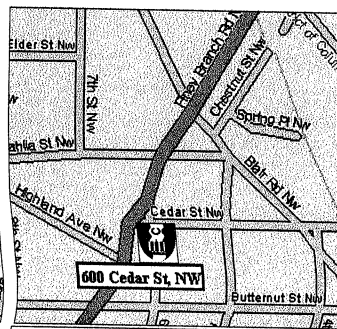

Vikings—At the National Museum of Natural History

The exhibition, "Vikings: The North Atlantic Saga," will commemorate the 1000-year anniversary of the Viking arrival in North America and explore the historical impact of new archaeological finds that have redefined the world's knowledge of early North American and Scandinavian life.

"Vikings" will open April 29, 2000 and continue through August 13, 2000. Recognized as an official project of the White House Millennium Council, "Vikings" is a \$3 million, 5500 sq. ft. exhibition comprised of more than 200 artifacts. These artifacts include Viking Age jewelry, wooden carvings, and grave goods dated from 800 to 1050 A.D.; medieval church carvings dated from 1050 to 1400 A.D., Romantic period (1800-1900's) paintings, and contemporary pop-culture items.

The exhibition brings together for the first time artifacts not only from Viking Scandinavian homelands (Denmark, Sweden and Norway) but also artifacts from Iceland, Greenland, Finland, Canada and the United States -- representing all the countries that the Vikings visited during their westward expansion.
