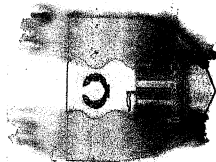

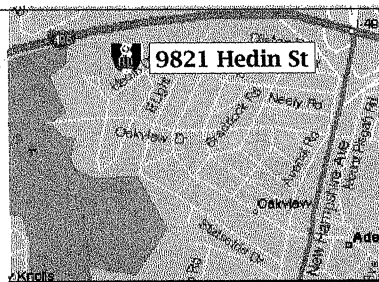
There will be a Storvik encampment at many of the camping events to come, so let your travel plans be known, so that we can organize gatherings.

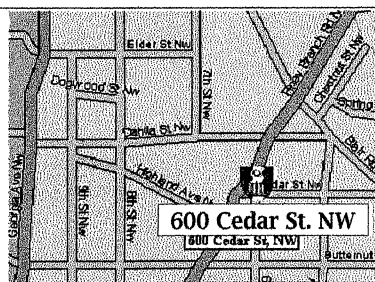
