Spring is upon us, and that can mean but one thing: War is in the air!

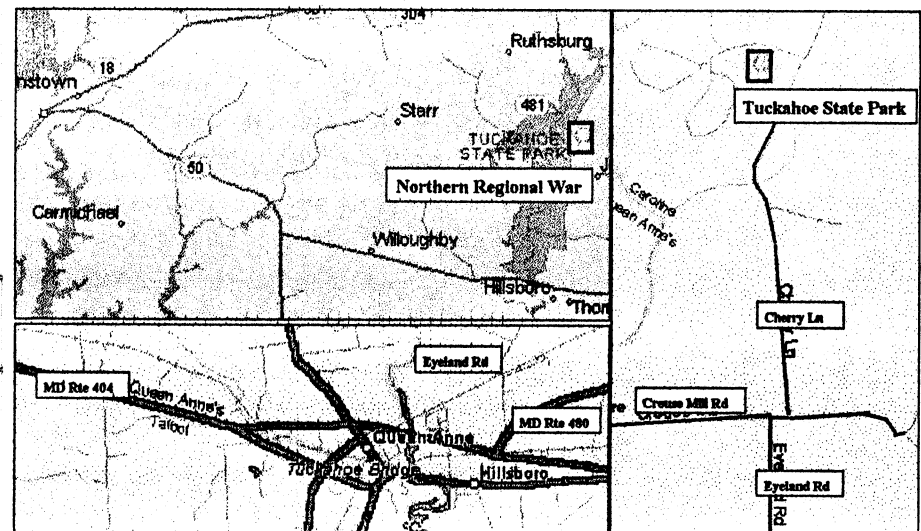

The site will be Tuckahoe State Park on the Eastern Shore of Maryland, located apx. 20 minutes east of the Chesapeake Bay Bridge. There is no site fee. The site opens at 9am, and will be available until sundown. There should be more than adequate parking available, but in the interest of space, carpooling is encouraged.

DIRECTIONS:

Take Maryland Route 50 East across the Chesapeake Bay Bridge. Follow Route 50 until you hit Route 404 East. Take 404 East for apx. 5 miles, make a left onto 480 East (Ridgely Rd), then an immediate left onto Eyeland Rd. Continue for 3.5 miles to Crouse Mill Rd. Make a right, then the first left to continue north along Cherry Ln. Go one-half mile until you will see the Campground entrance on the left. Enter there, follow the signs past the Ball Field towards the north Group Camping Loop. Signs will show where the athletic field and parking will be.

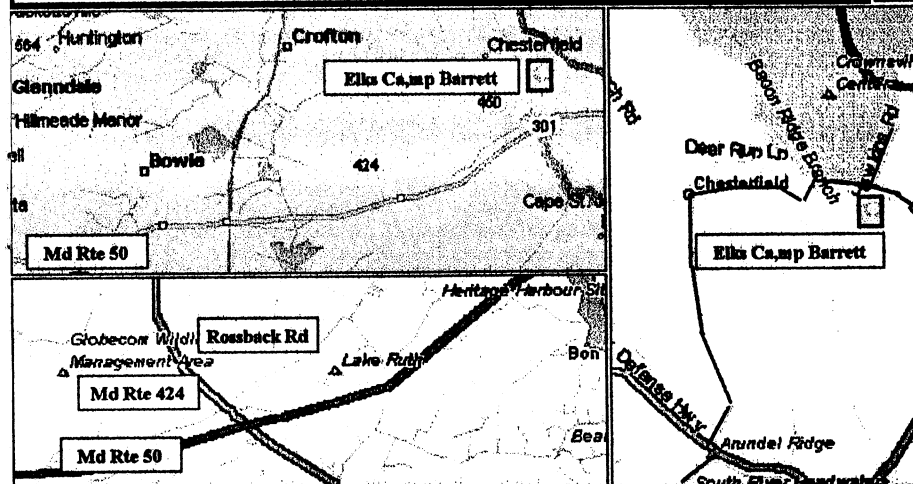

FROM RT. 50: Take exit #16, Rt. 424 Davidsonville Road North. Turn **RIGHT** onto Rossback Rd (the first **RIGHT** after getting onto Davidsonville Rd). After 1.2 miles Rossback Rd ends in a Y intersection (watch carefully, it's easy to miss). Turn **LEFT** onto Rutland Rd. After 2.6 miles turn **LEFT** at the stop sign onto Rt. 450 General's Highway. Take the very next **RIGHT** onto St. Stephen's Church Rd. After 1.1 miles, turn **RIGHT** onto Chesterfield Rd. Go .75 miles, Elks Camp Barrett is on the right side of the intersection of Chesterfield Rd and Hawkins Rd.

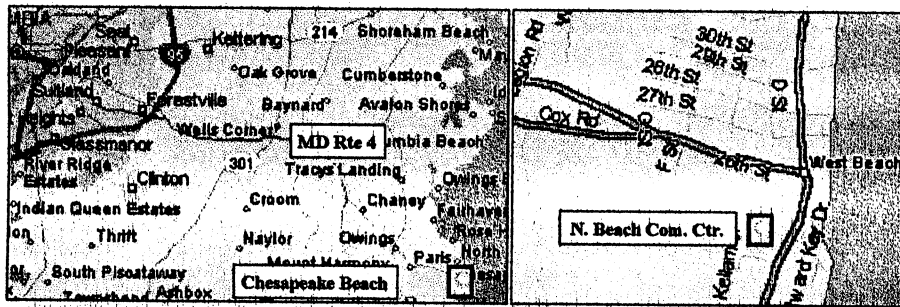
There is no eating in the Community Center, but you may eat on the wonderful deck outside. Pets are not allowed. The site is DRY.

From I-495: Take Rt 4, Pennsylvania Avenue (MD Exit 11) east. Go 17 miles to the left exit at Route 260 (Chesapeake Beach Rd). Follow Rte 260 to the end, 8 miles. Follow directions below.

From Rte 301 Corridor: Follow Rt 301 to Upper Marlboro & the junction with Rte 4. Take Rte 4 east (away from Wash.) for 6 miles to the left exit at Rte 260 (Chesapeake Beach Rd). Follow Rte 260 8 miles to end. Follow directions below.

Once in Chesapeake Beach (on Rte 260): Follow Rt 260 to the end. Make a right on Rt 261 (Bayside Road) and go about 1/4 mile to Gordon Stinnett Avenue. You can see the NECC from the road—it has a very blue roof. Make a right on Gordon Stinnett, then a left immediately past the waterpark into the parking lot. The Center is the large gray building with the blue roof. The entrance is by the flagpole.

Her Excellency, Baroness Johanna, has asked that I convey to the citizenry of Storvik a warning of impending danger to the security of our lands. Not wishing to begin her reign with a message of strife, she nevertheless will not endanger her subjects by allowing them to remain in ignorance of a grave threat to their well being—and so this task falls to me, your Chronicler.

During the reign of Corun and Brenna, it became known that our enemies were somehow gaining sensitive information. It was this breach of secrecy that in part forced Storvik to take up arms last year in their victorious defense of our territory in Middle Marlboro.

In order to help forestall the need for further military action, a ruse was devised whereby information known to be false would be accepted as accurate—that Storvik had the historic rights of possession over Lower (not Middle Marlboro) and that the Barony of Lochmere was a signatory to the so-called "Maritime Defense Treaty" announced at Court during the Northern Regional Twelfth Night. Sadly, this stratagem was only partly successful; we do not know who has given our secrets to our enemies, we are uncertain who is the foreign rodent gnawing so diligently at the good will of our neighbors, but we DO know at least one of the conduits this vermin travels by—the one that leads to the Barony of Dun Carraig!

At great personal risk I have obtained a copy of "Clyffe Notes"—supposedly the official publication of Dun Carraig. After reading this innuendo-filled collection of half-truths and misrepresentations, it is painfully clear that someone is attempting to mislead Phillip of Ghent & Minowara Kiritsubo (the Thegn & Bantheign of Dun Carraig) in hopes of engendering discord, fostering dissension, and—dare I say it—perhaps even rekindling the fires of war! What follows are excerpts from the calumnies & falsehoods contained within...

"A division of responsibility for patrol of the waters of (all) Northern Atlantia has been implemented." Under whose authority and by what right is this justified? There has been no agreement by Storvik, Bright Hills, Highland Foorde, Roxbury Mill, Ponte Alto, or Stierbach to abrogate their own responsibilities as to the defense of their own borders.

"Our Potomac River." "...our defense of the Upper Potomac." "Consideration is being given to renaming our river." The citizens of Dun Carraig can call the Lower Potomac whatever they want. If, after consultation with our neighbors to the west and north AND after receiving the Crown's approval, there is a desire to rename the Upper Potomac, WE will collectively rename it—as is OUR (not Dun Carraig's) right.

"Shouldering this responsibility made it unacceptably risky to dispatch expeditionary forces to patrol other waters." "We are now able to provide much greater defense...of all of Northern Atlantia." Two sparsely populated territories undertaking to defend all of the rest of Northern Atlantia, any one territory of which has a greater population than Dun Carraig and Spiaggia Levantina combined? This is a dubious proposition at best.

But this was not all. At our Good Baroness's Investiture, a Dun Carraig officer was asked by what right did they claim authority over the Anacostia River, which flows entirely within Borders of Storvik. He replied, "To where do its waters flow?" and then claimed jurisdiction because the *current* eventually led through Dun Carraig. When challenged that by this logic, they could claim the rain that falls from the sky, he tried to weasel out of this by saying "We would never claim that!"

And then there is the dubious treaty itself, only two points of which need be touched upon now.

Throughout this document, references are made to the strength of the signatories and their ability to defend all of Northern Atlantia. Can we believe in their martial competence when Dun Carraig, at least, could not make good on its notoriously false claim to Middle Marlboro? Should Storvik (and our neighbors) just scurry into a rat-hole of complacency by trusting a well-meaning but ill-advised and unenforceable treaty to do our job for us?

The treaty also claims "the right to raise and levy upon these states fair and equitable assessments..." Even Their Majesties took umbrage at this clause, reminding the signatories that the CROWN retains the right to assess taxes on its holdings. And the weasel-worded response to this was "No-one said anything about taxes." A rat renamed as a mouse is no less rabid!

So Citizens of Storvik, be wary! Those who work against your rights to live peacefully would follow a tuneless piper through the streets of strife—and they would drag you down the nearest rat-hole with them!
