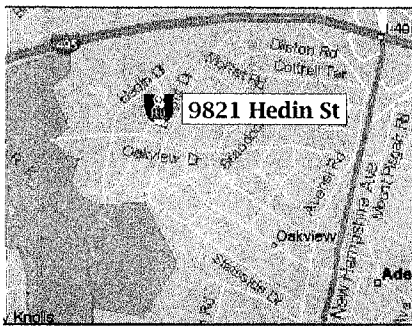

At that time we shall speak of preparations for our Kingdom Crusade of the fall, to defend our Northern Border.

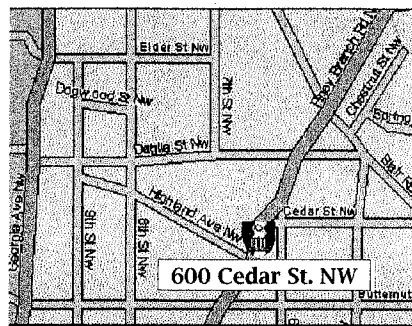
Until we meet again, in the hall or on the field, I remain yours, in service to Storbik and Atlantia-
