



Old Business:

Business Cards: \$50 for 500; new design approved.

<u>Canvas</u>: Still in the works.

Children's Names on Website: Still under works.

Hoods: Patterns being sewn on.

Medallions: Pricing is different than originally planned; \$300 approved initially, but actual price is \$600. Price difference includes exclusivity of design PLUS triple the number of medallions! What about people who have already received a Silkie/Lozulet/Owl? Can they purchase a medallion? This to be discussed.

<u>Pennsic</u>: Storvik Court at 6:00 pm Monday of War Week. Held under Kingdom Pavilion on the field. Afterwards there will be an "Historic Pennsic Walking Tour" with various Barons and Baronesses.

New Business:

New Business (Continued):

Fighter Practice: Cancelled during War Week and the two weeks thereafter.

<u>Fighter Practice Site</u>: New contract negotiated with longer hours, but rates have tripled; great load on EVERYONE. Gauss sent word that we started at \$600 per year with Oldcastle paying half. Outdoor sites available. What about expecting contributions? Maybe we should have a contribution/cost meter next to Fighter Practice jar to show what is being made that particular night. We should publicize our costs. More active fundraising is needed.

Set a maximum for Baronial contributions. Let people know if we're going to cancel practice. Checks would be tax deductible. Maybe we should do this for two quarters and see what happens. Find other sites as backup.

Volunteers needed for signs. Post info to appropriate areas. Can we get money from other baronies? (Probably not)

Will have an official designee to handle monies and deposit. Will check to see if extended hours generate more money. Signing of contract approved, but overall issue is to be revisited at the October meeting.

Autocrat Report on Storvik Rovice and Unbelt Tourney

On July 8-10, 2005, Storvik held their annual Novice Tournament.

This year we reinstated the Unbelt Tourney to great success. Thanks to Duke Badouin's letter to the Chivalry, we had a great turnout of both fighter and Knights. Our teaching/guidance staff included three Dukes both days.

We hosted an A&S competition, a Brewing competition, a Novice Heavy tourney, a Novice Rapier tourney, an Unbelt Heavy tourney, a youth practice, melee scenarios, and archery activities (both target and combat). We offered ten classes and had a Herald's Point.

It was a two-night camping event with fires and bardic circles both evenings. On Saturday evening, we had two guitars and a drum, along with numerous singers. At one point there were close to 30 people around the circle.

Even with a low Troll price, extravagant prizes, and a late event announcement, we were able to bring in \$99 from the event itself. This was supported by \$950.50 worth of fundraising; this included \$137.50 for the Kingdom Travel Fund, \$565 for the Barony's Fighter Practice fund, and \$228 for the Newcomers' fund that we will be creating.

We had 18 authorizations or renewals.

The weather was beautiful. The biggest catastrophes for the day were running low on \$1 bills, hot water in the water bearing hoses, and someone stepping on the hose connection.

We had two complaints—

- 1) One fighter's family was 'run over' by Rapiers. Roland was nearby and spoke to the Rapiers in question, resolving the issue.
- 2) The A&S contest was relegated to a tiny table under the short pavilion with lots of trash, while being completely overwhelmed by the Auctions. In the future, the auctions will not be held so close to the A&S exhibits.

After a bumpy start, we managed both a new food format (which we should try again, only with better advertising) and our A&S competition.
