I will not be hosting an 'at home' this month, but will be visiting family. Please join me again in January.

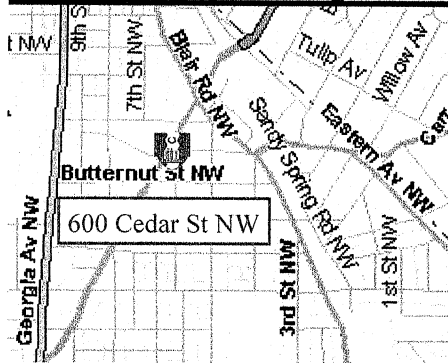

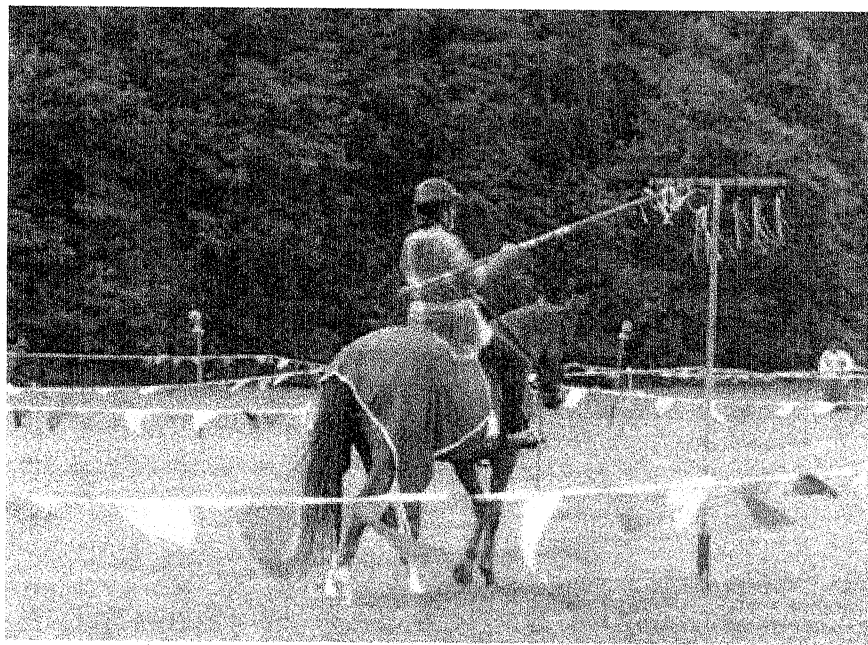
Unto all who read these presents, greetings!
