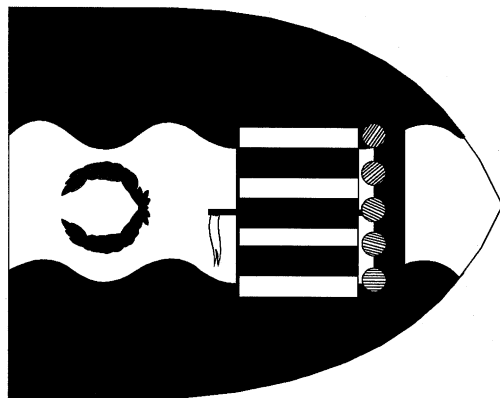

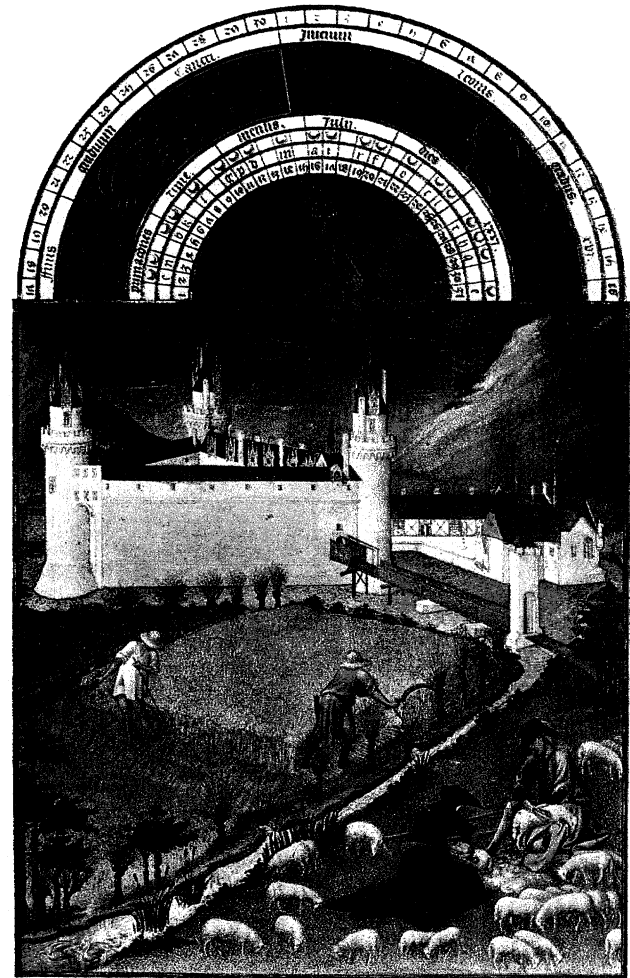

## Officer Reports—

Baron & Baroness - Nothing to report

Seneschal - Doomsday report will be filed Tuesday. We officially need a Chatelaine (\*AHEM\* See Chatelaine's report, below). Magnus is doing children's activities. Anyone anticipating stepping down from their position within the next four to six months needs to find and train a deputy to take over for them.

Archery Marshall - Not present.

Minister of Arts & Sciences - Monthly A&S meetings ongoing. January's meeting had 4 people.

She would like to talk about these meetings as they don't seem to be fulfilling original expectations. Scriptorium is ongoing. Attendance has dropped. This month's topic is 14th century french batarde. The MOAS quarterly report, due on the 15th, will be on time. Each quarterly report includes details on individuals A&S projects; therefore, please e-mail her about what you're doing each quarter and she'll include it in the report.

Chatelaine - Johanna and Patrick bought tubs to put chatelaine stuff in. It's currently at Patrick's.

Nina Schreuders has volunteered to be Chatelaine (Huzzah, and similar salutary sentiments).

Chancellor of Children's Activities - Children's activities will be concurrent with Baronial at-home at Corun's. Topic for February 10 is heraldry and favors for St. Valentine's holiday.

Chronicler - Warrant is official. The Drekkar needs to be out sooner (The official deadline for mailing out issues is about four days to a week before the end of the month)—therefore, it WILL be! A new address label program, allowing both Society and Mundane names to be included on the address, as well as other useful abilities, has been purchased. The Chronicler is going back to school (he doesn't want to be a Disgruntled Postal Worker forever) and will be taking computer publishing courses for both his degree and the betterment of the Drekkar.

Exchequer - Has determined final bank balance and is working on Doomsday Report. Will be filed by the end of the month (15 days before the deadline). Current balance is still about \$4000.

Herald - not present.

Knight Marshall - Everything is good. Everyone is taking it easy over the winter. Storvik has been invited/challenged to war practice with Bright Hills in May (the day after Garb Wars, May 17).

Minister of the Lists - Has a fighter list as of Oct 15, 1997.

Rapier Marshall - The Rapier Marshall is currently attending the Thursday night practice with Ponte Alto. He is also **\*actively\*** (this is a HINT, people!) looking for a deputy to succeed him.

Web Minister - Web page is up to date. The Web Minister and the Chronicler will be working out a means to regularly transfer of information so as to keep the Storvik web page up to date.

## OB Business—

Chatelaine's position has now been filled.

Haven't heard anything from the Quaker school about their demo, so it appears to have been cancelled.

Cooks Guild—has a final inventory. The barony owns a lot of things for making roast meat, but no pots. Now we need some pots. Chatelaine is planning to buy new pots (4 @ 20-30 quarts), new serving platters, and bread baskets. In addition, MacGregor is going to donate a large extra heavy-duty frying pan along with some mixing bowls.

Baronial coronets - Thorbrandr is still planning on making new coronets. Igor and Fevronia have made an offer of \$200 for the old coronets. These were originally made for Igor & Fevronia's reign and would have great significance for them. Motion passed to allow them to buy them after we obtain new coronets.

Correction to last month's new business. The Baroness was hand fasted to Gauss Magnusson, not Magnus. The assembled Great Ones officially annulled the "Magnus Handfasting" owing to a lack of consummation.

## OB Business (Continued)—

Principality - Our Exchequer, Lord Patrick, is the representative from the committee setting up the Principality proposal to the barony of Storvik. Any questions from the barony should be directed to him. There is going to be a monthly bulletin produced about principality issues. Suggestion was made to put a subscription form for it in the Drekkar.

## New Business—

Exchequer has suggested the Post-Pennsic Revel be free this year because the Barony is in good financial straits. The lowest profit made in an event in the last three years was \$12 (Celt Wars). Decision was made to revisit the issue by the May barony meeting so that the event announcement can be put in the July Acorn. Also, Exchequer will do a complete projection of what the Barony has, what it has promised out, and what it needs over the year.

Magnus McKinley and Gauss Magnusson have discussed doing a brewing oriented event in the fall. Magnus is volunteering to put together a baronial Brewer's Guild. The Baron stated the Taster's Guild will be run through the Baron's office.

Events: Yule Revel made money. Not sure how much yet. The hall was fairly cool. The event was fairly well attended. Motion was passed to declare the event a success. Stefan (was) volunteered to write a report of everything that happened there for the Drekkar.

Performer's Revel - Things are going forward. By the time you read this, it will be too late to make reservations.

Straight to the Heart - Event is canceled because the church forgot it was holding a homeless shelter that same day. The church graciously offered the site to Ponte Alto on February 28th for its baronial birthday.

Northern Regional War Practice - The day after St. Paddy's day bloodbath. Held by Ponte Alto.

Baronial Championship/Birthday - May 31st. We have a cook (MacGregor) and a site (Croom).

Celt Wars - June 27th. Would like to do feast in camp instead of picnic site (to save money and not make people have to drive there). Need to look into renting or borrow tables. Courtney wants to know if there is anything people would like to do there. The possibility of fencing was mentioned. Site has not been reserved yet, but Autocrat doesn't anticipate problems. Roxbury will most likely hold a regional war practice the next day on the same site.

Novice Tourney - July 11th. The date has been reserved by the kingdom for the A&S festival. The question was asked if we want to put in a bid to host it, since they don't have a site yet. That way we could hold our Novice Tourney at the same time. We would need to find a site.

Post Pennsic Revel - See above under new business.

Marlboro Wars - Proposed event between Storvik, Dun Carriag and Lochmere to be held at Croom in Upper Marlboro. October 31st seems to be the best date. Other dates were the 22nd or 29th of August. Lochmere will need to reserve the site since Storvik—because of other events—cannot reserve it. There should be a Co-Autocrat from each of the three Baronies with one acting as the "top" Autocrat. Volunteers were solicited. Gauss Magnusson volunteered to be Storvik's Autocrat.

## The Moghul Sweep (Bright Hills' Baronial Birthday)

Announcing the 4th Birthday celebration of the Bright Hills, and the first years' tenure of Temur and Ekaterina, Baron and Baroness. In honor of this great occasion, and with great deference to Baron Temur's position as Khan of the Clan White Wing, a feast incorporating dishes from China, Persia, the Moghul Empire, and the Himalayas will be served. Site opens at 10am and closes at 10pm. There will be feasting, dancing, singing, and festivities beyond your wildest imaginings. There will be gnashing of teeth and rending of garb if you miss this one.

Activities: There will be two A&S competitions and a display. One competition will be for any items in the Baronial colors of Black, White, and Gold. The second will be of items of an Asian or Middle Eastern nature—this can include anything from Persia to Japan, and can be armor, food, clothing or textiles, jewelry, or anything, so long as it can be documented as Asian or Middle Eastern. The "Look What I Did" display will feature works by members of the Barony, and is not limited to period or SCA items. We will also have classes, a Middle Eastern Drumming and Dancing Workshop, and one area of the Hall will be set aside as a Decadence Den—with lounging on pillows and carpets, burning of incense, and nibbling of sweet tidbits.

A fabulous FEAST will be prepared by Lord Havelyard of Bourne, featuring an array of comestibles. Part of the hall will feature low tables on carpets, so bring cushions or pillows on which to sit. (We'd also appreciate any rugs you can bring to cover the concrete floor.) The rest of the hall will have traditional tables for convenience and comfort. (We wish to please everyone.)

The cost in advance is \$12.00 on-board, \$6.00 off-board; after January 20th or at the door \$14.00 on-board, \$7.00 off-board. The feast is limited to 100 people, so make reservations early! Reservations not claimed by 3:00 pm will be sold at Troll. Make checks payable to The Barony of the Bright Hills/SCA, Inc., and send them to the Autocrat, Lady Isabel of Biconyll (Izzie); state your preference for floor or table seating. Directions: Take your best route to I-695 (Baltimore Beltway) and travel to the northwest corner. Take I-795 north towards Owings Mills, continue till I-795 ends, and go through the light. Turn left at the second light onto MD Rte 30 north. Continue about 10 miles to Hampstead. The Hampstead Volunteer Fire Company is on the right side of Main Street, after the 4th light. If you reach the 5th light at MD 482, you've gone too far. Drive all the way around the building until you reach the upper parking lot on the left side.

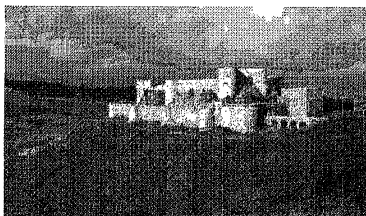
