

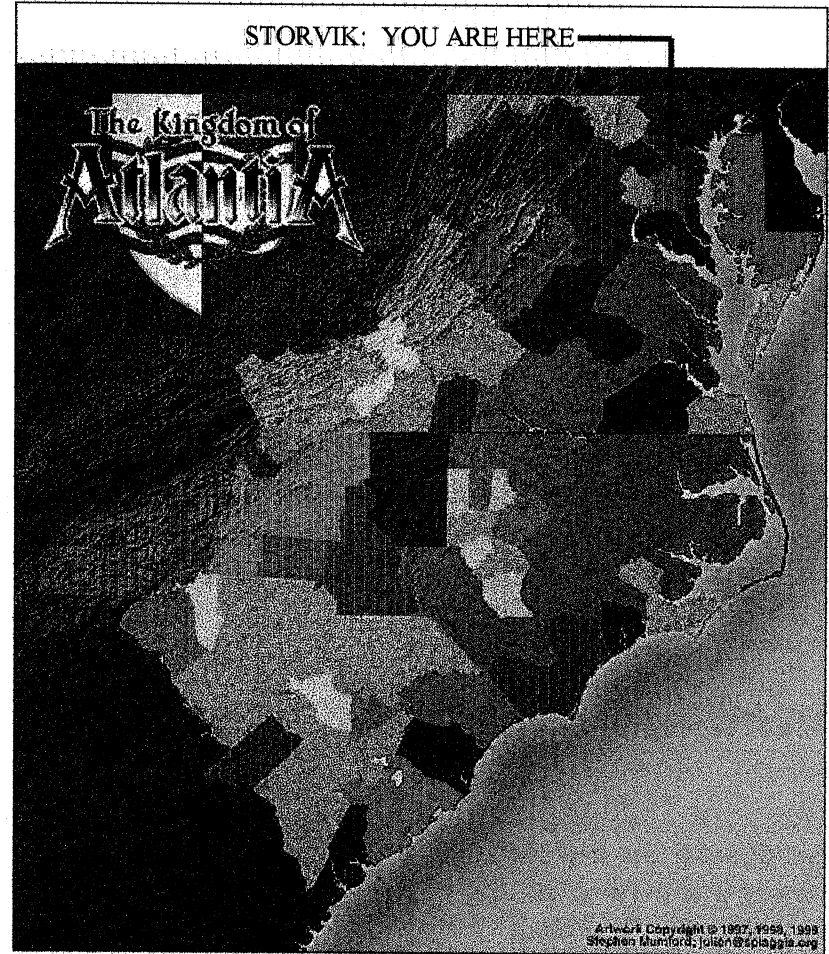

Unto the glorious populace of Storvik does Brenna and Corun give greetings,

As many of you may have heard, a joint-defense treaty involving the Barony of Dun Carraig, the Barony of Lochmere, and the Canton of Spiaggia Levantina was announced at the Northern Principality Twelfth Night. Although the intent of these worthies is admirable, there was one clause that we found worrisome—the bit about the signatories having the right to levy an assessment on surrounding Baronies and Shires to pay for the expenses of this defense. 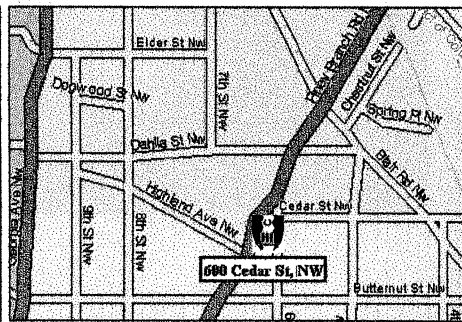

FROM I-95: Take exit 54, Temple Ave. At the light at the bottom of the ramp, turn right and go under the Interstate. Go through SIX traffic lights. You will cross the Appomattox River after the 3rd light. (After the 5th light, do NOT bear to the right following signs for "Fort Lee". Go straight). After going through the 6th light, you will enter Fort Lee. Once you pass the guardhouse, turn right at the 2nd light onto A Ave. Mifflin Hall is a large brick building, and will be on your left at the corner of 21st and A Ave. Park in large parking lot behind the building.

FROM I-295: Take exit 9B, Route 36 (Hopewell). Go through 3 lights & turn left at the 4th light to enter Fort Lee. Once you pass the guardhouse, turn right at the 2nd light onto A Ave. Mifflin Hall is a large brick building and will be on your left at the corner of 21st and A Ave. Park in the large lot behind the building.

FROM I-85: As I-85 ends, you are directed onto I-95 North. Take immediate exit onto Route 36 towards Fort Lee. (If you miss exit, go to exit 54; follow directions for I-95 above). Drive through Petersburg on Route 36. After passing entrance to Petersburg Battlefield Park, turn right at first light into Fort Lee (Lee Ave); move into left lane. Turn left at light onto A Ave. Mifflin Hall is a large brick building on right at corner of 21st & A Ave. Park in large parking lot behind the building.

Dancing & drumming competitions during the day. A dancing competition will be held, both individual & group. Feast cooked by Baron Havelyard & his Help. They have a score to settle.
