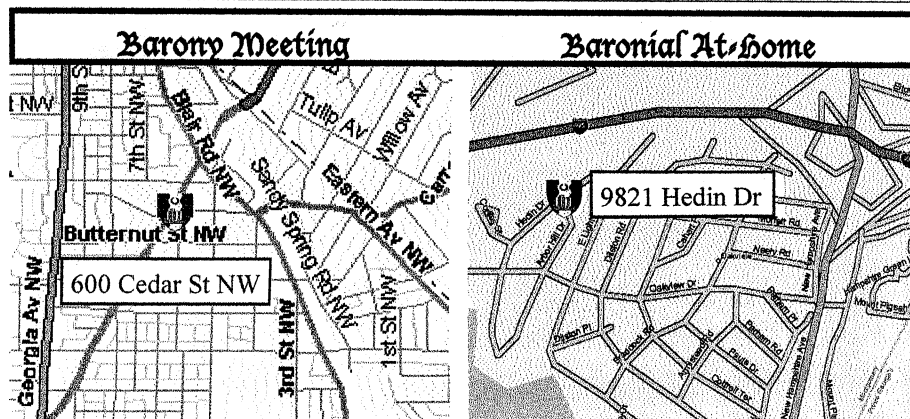

### Officers' Reports:

**Baroness:** From Unevent--Kingdom wants more Baronial "Oomph!" Kingdom A&S to have a Display of Champions. King & Queen want people to talk with them concerning on-line recommendations. Big push for attendance at Gulf Wars.

**Seneschal:** From Unevent--Attended Target Archery, Heavy Marshall, and Combat Archery meetings--what is the Chain of Command for these? Seneschal and Event Autocrat are NOT in CoC. Earl Marshall (if present) for the particular discipline & Warranted Marshall are.

Should Atlantia adopt padded or unpadded polearms? Inside Atlantia padded required, outside can be unpadded.

**Archer Marshall:** Combat Archery--Removal of special symbol on Archers as armor requirements are the same as for Fighters. What is an "Archery Kill?"--a "telling blow." Pound pullage on bows not to change. Crossbows--some are passing, but there is an inconsistency in results (some bruising is occurring).

Target Archery--Royal Rounds will count if there is a warranted Marshall present. Novice Badge to be eliminated (0-19, Novice without bardic; 20-39, Bowman with 3 Royal Rounds). Different shoots to be posted and recorded.

Equestrian Archery--To be approved.

**Arts & Sciences:** Kingdom A&S to change because of Twelfth Night. MOAS list on line is for everyone, not just A&S officers. Ymir is a Viking theme with stuff from Viking museum; competitions are being strongly pushed.

**Castellan:** No report.

**Chronicler:** Online roster to be updated. Open call for editor of "The Oak." Requested an earlier than normal letter from the Baroness because of the holidays.

**Exchequer:** \$5314.66 currently in treasury. The Kingdom Exchequer and Seneschal must be notified for any outside fundraising at SCA events

## January 29: Lochmere, A Feast at the Court of Phillip the Good, Duke of Burgundy

Phillip, by right and title Duke of Burgundy, Count of Holland and Hainaut, overlord of Brabant, Limberg and the lands of Flanders, sends greetings and bids all to whom these letters come to present themselves at His Court for a feast of the winter hunt, to take place on the 29th day of January, being 2005 in the Common Era at his manor in Lochmere.

Upon this day there shall be diverse entertainments such as may suit His Grace's court, to wit dancing, singing, playing at cards and dice, and coursing of hounds. That all might know His Grace's wealth and power, his cooks (by name Master Robear de Bardoulf and his noble apprentice Valharlic Caligula Aurelius) shall put forth a fine supper to suit the season, and there shall be much revelry and merry-making into the night.

In celebration of this day, all are asked to wear their finest raiment of the Burgundian Court, & to accouter themselves likewise, that the hall will be made more fair by the presence of banners & fine table linens, silver and bright candles.
