

day in December only. Where visited by a journalism student from AU doing a feature story exercise (no publication anticipated). Gauss attended Unevent Combat Archer Marshall's meeting

Exchequer: Current balance of funds \$5932.69. Review of books completed. Needs to add information on Baronial Bank Account into newsletter. Working on a link to information that will allow non-Exchequers to understand Doomsday Report. Putting together list of typical expenses & income (very rough draft) with plan to eventually use for creating real budgets. Newsletter liability—figures weren't fully accurate because of a misunderstanding amongst several officers as to how Drekkar was funded. Particular problem was that partial subscriptions were pro-rated, not required to have payment for a full year. Gauss attended Unevent Exchequer's meeting.

Old Business:

Unevent: Storvik is no longer on any form of probation for any reason; all issues (financial and otherwise) cleared up. Quarters are being changed to allow reports to come out in advance of Board of Directors meeting.

Financial Policy: We are not required to submit a yearly budget. Also working on a fully consistent definition of the word "publish" so that we can conform to the intent of providing public information on our finances.

Croom: We have no meeting before Croom reservation calendar opens for 2006. Contacts will be made regarding our desires for specific dates and a report will be made at the next meeting.

Renegotiation of Price of Church for Fighter Practice: Not using full available time at this point...possibly because of early onset of darkness during this time of year. We are currently looking at a shortfall of between \$300-\$400 for this year. We had been hoping to have more people contribute to the Fighter Practice fund on a regular basis, although regular donations are still occurring; such donations are tax deductible. Barony had agreed to donate \$600 originally. Decision made to continue with current use of the Church site for a full year to provide an accurate baseline of costs before any decision is made as to whether we should try to renegotiate costs and/or hours.

New Business:

Fighter Practice Funds deposits: We need another stamp that says "For Deposit Only" with the account numbers for any checks that we get as a donation during a Fighter Practice. William authorized to purchase another.

Staples Cards: These provide a discount on our purchases, but not every Officer is currently using them. Arbogast to email the account number to all Officers so they can start doing so.

Drekkar: Arbogast will provide templates to Magnus so he can begin conversion to electronic format. Now that we are converting to an online newsletter, we need to send a postcard to all current subscribers so that they know that the default delivery mode will be electronic and not hard copy. This means that, unless someone needing a Drekkar cannot receive the electronic version, there will be no more hard copies other than those required by Kingdom Law. Arbogast has stepped down effective the end of December, but will serve a short time further as Deputy Chronicler; Magnus will step up immediately. These two and the Seneschal will meet to finalize this and to have Arbogast turn over all Baronial property.

Event Sites: We have a database in the Baronial Yahoo Group of 16 to 18 potential sites with points of contact and current prices. If anyone knows of additional sites they are invited to add to the listing.
