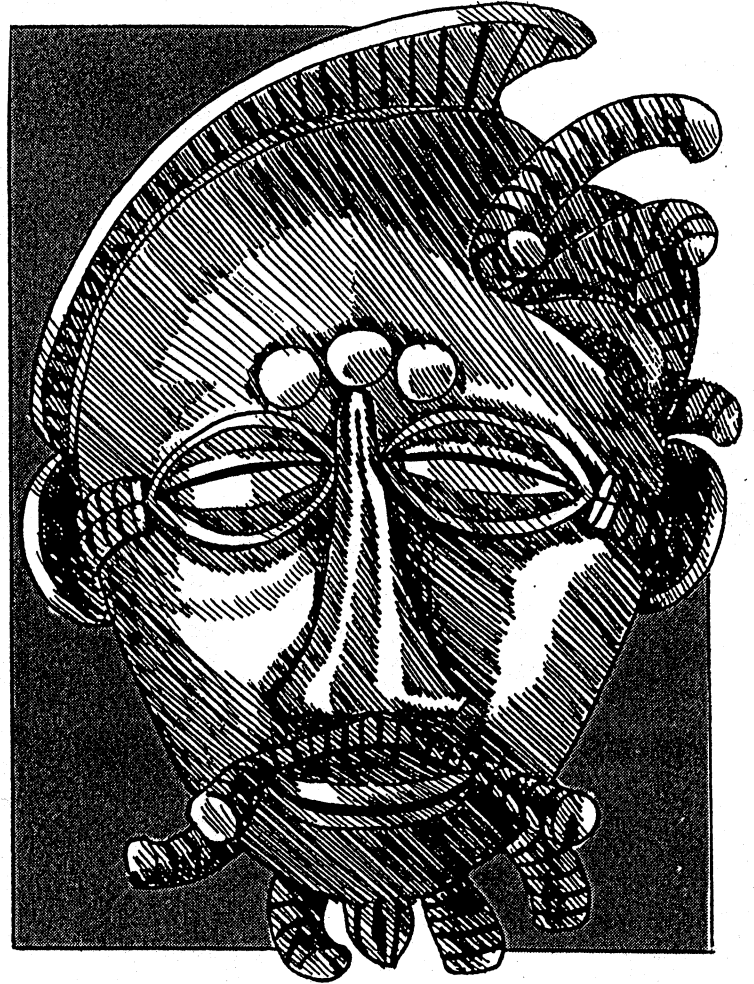

Minutes from Baronial Meeting on 12/11/95

OFFICER REPORTS

Baroness - The autocrats of Twelfth Night have requested that each Barony sponsor a fighter from out of Kingdom. The officers voted to request that private funds be used.

Chronicler - Expiration of subscriptions will be changed to December of each year. All current subscriptions will be prorated and subscribers notified. Four (4) subscription renewals.

Seneschal - All doomsday reports need to be sent out. Copies should go to the Seneschal. A report is needed from all autocrats so that the Seneschal is kept informed. Also, Stierbach is in the process of becoming a Barony.

Arts & Sciences - An order for arts and sciences needs to be created. All suggestions are welcome.

Heavy Weapons Marshal - A round robin tourney was held last Monday at fighter practice. Thirteen (13) people participated. See announcement from Sean. There are new kill rules for archers. They must be touched to be declared dead. A request was put forth at Unevent for a boffer marshal for the children. This will instill proper fighting techniques while they are still young.

NEW BUSINESS

SENECHAL UNEVENT REPORT

Financial report of all local events should go to the Kingdom Exchequer or Regional Deputy within one (1) month of the event. Be timely!

Report to Seneschal should include a copy of all reports of the event - exchequer, marshal, MoL, and chiurgeon - awards and anything else of note.

Non-member surcharge will be stopped if there is an "alternative source of SOLID funding." Ideas are being sought. In the meantime, a check still goes to Milpitas and with notice sent to Master Thomas, so he can make sure Atlantia gets credit.

Master Thomas is working on an Autocrats handbook.

Atlantia is growing in population - mostly family memberships.

Red Tape - still has not been published. Discussing the potential for putting it on the Atlantia homepage.

Acorn - considering the possibility of publishing the Acorn over E-mail also. A suggestion was made to change to a tabloid size format with room for pictures, maps, etc.

New waivers - published in the Nov. 1995 Acorn - opinions sought.

Finances - Atlantia operates on \$7000/yr. Funds must be raised somewhere. Suggested - 15 year T shirts to sell at Kingdom Events - possibly starting at Emerald Joust.

Courtesy - absence thereof - SCAdians are responsible for teaching newcomers and reminding each other that honor and courtesy are the center of the SCA.

Sea Wars - Atlantia & Trimaris are working on an event for the summer in the Savannah area.

BOD - new and improved (?) - Policy changes require 60 days notice, 30 days in case of emergency. Foreign groups are growing smaller. Also, many countries are after them to incorporate nationally and pay them taxes. The US non-profit status is not being recognized. Milpitas is receiving reports of problems with polling, labels, addresses, etc.

Performer's Revel - Nothing to report.

Never To Early For Love - \$340 site fee, \$170 deposit has been made. Event will run from 12 noon - 11 pm. A demo was excepted as barter for a lower site fee. This obligation will be fulfilled on a Friday AT 1pm in the Spring.

Announcements of the event have already gone out to the other Baronies. Site fee is \$11. Felicia is organizing the music group. There will be a full procession and a court. There will be a total of five bout sessions.

As the Holidays and New Year approach us, I would like to personally extend my warmest regards to you and yours. I hope your season is filled with great memories and lasting good cheer. I am pleased to inform you that the Monday evening practices are going well. As we enter late fall and winter we have been very lucky on those nights to have great weather.

To make practices a little more interesting we are going to start with two special monthly practices having a theme. Beginning in Dec. the first Monday of the month will be a tourney practice night. This tourney will be the first thing on the agenda. We will use round robin and or double-elim style lists, so everybody can practice more than once. All skill levels are invited, remember this practice but a tourney. Get all the butterflys out during practice and fight better when it counts! An interesting prize has been devised. It will be explained at the first tourney practice.

Hopefully I will be able to find an aspiring MoL to run the lists. To facilitate the evening events, we'll want to start the first bouts at 7:30 pm so this will be cut off time for assembling the lists. If we find it's too early or too late we'll change the time and put the word out.

We would like to try a once a month melee practice at the George mason site. This practice will be held on the THIRD Tuesday of the month. Small melees and tactics for the unit and small groups will be concentrated on. Access to melee weapons is limited. If you have any, PLEASE bring them to this practice so we can simulate shield wall/spear confrontations along with other scenerios.

The first tourney practice will be held on 4 DEC 95. As to avoid the holiday, the next tourney practice will be held on the 8 JAN 96. Then on 6 FEB 96 as scheduled. The first melee practice will be held on the 19 DEC 95. As the weather changes for the better we will most probably increase sites and frequency of the melee practices. But for the winter try to keep your skills up once a month. During these melee practices, formations and movement in these formations will be explained, shown, and everyone will have a chance to practice what they learned. That's right a little marching never hurt. These basic skills will be keep the unit together in combat. If we can become proficient, we could clean up the battle field. Gradually, we can introduce combat and movement. Once we master it at practice we will be able to scrimmage with another local unit. Hope this peeks your interest and I really hope to see you at practice!!!

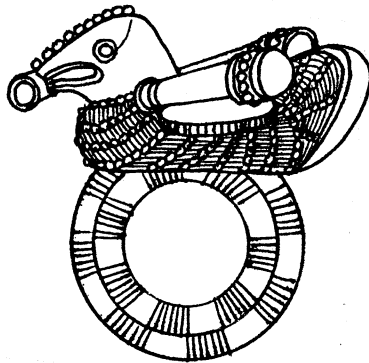

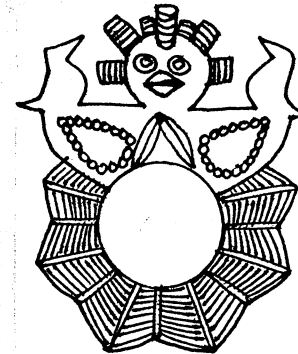

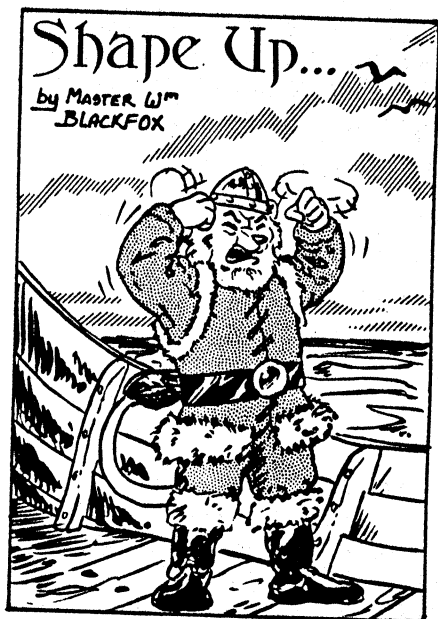
