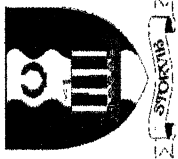


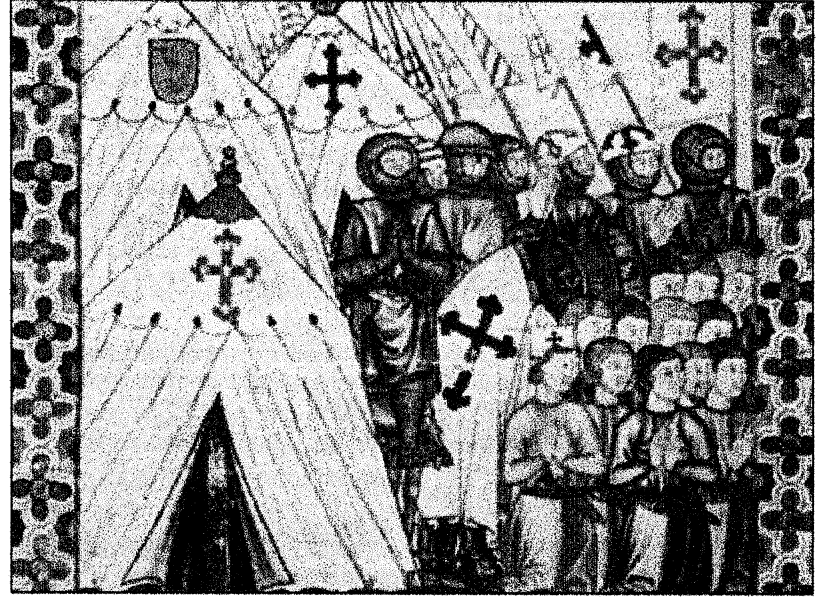

give greetings,

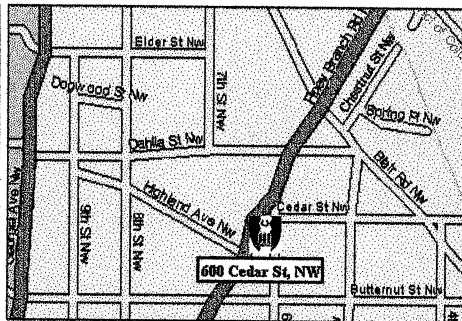

Cleaning Supplies Pack - Baronial property for events.

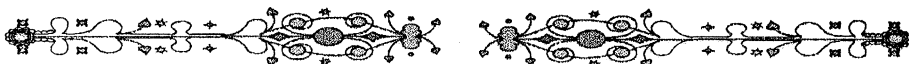

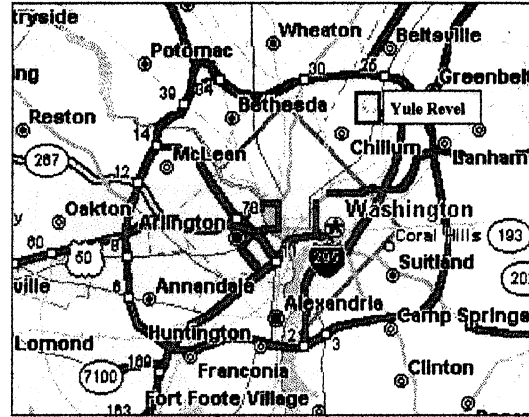
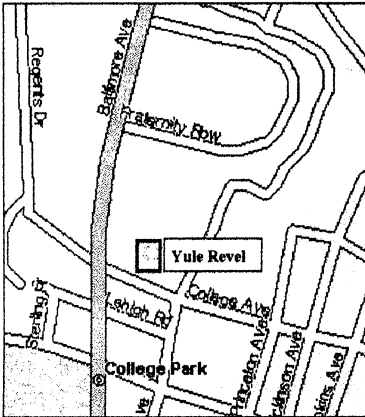
Children are welcome to join in the festivities, but no child care will be provided. The Hall can be wheelchair accessible, but PLEASE contact the autocrat.

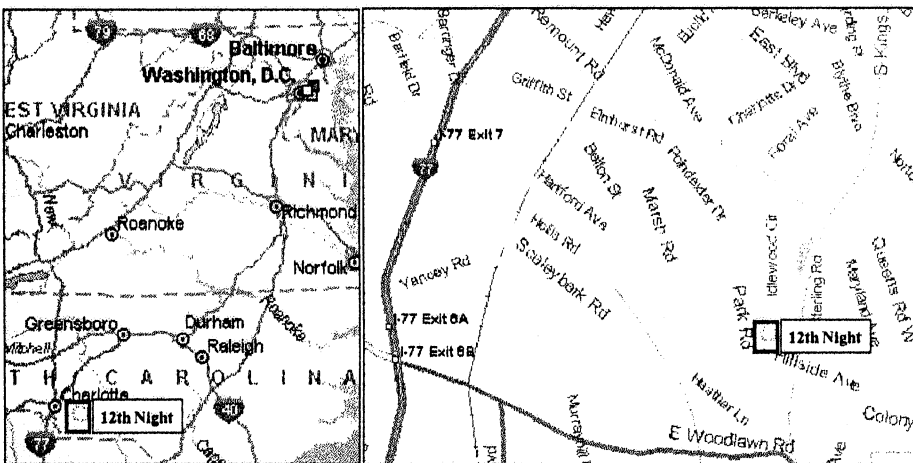

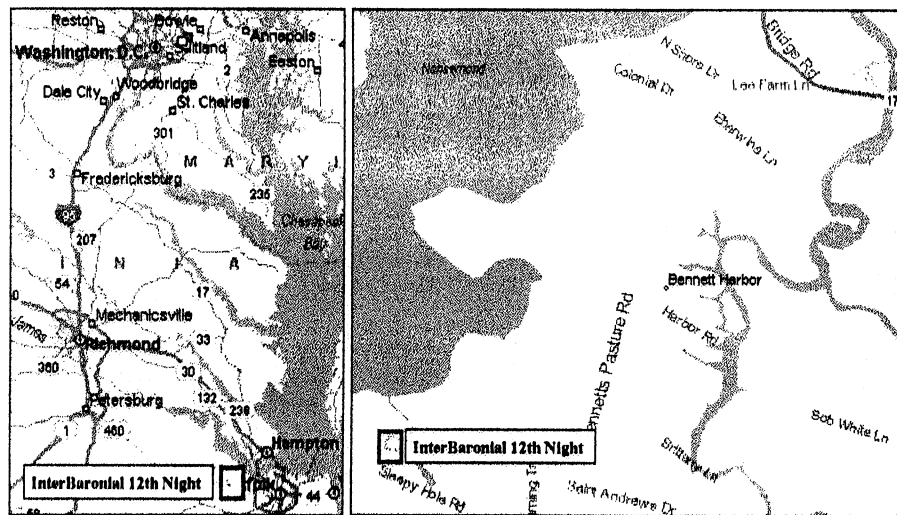
