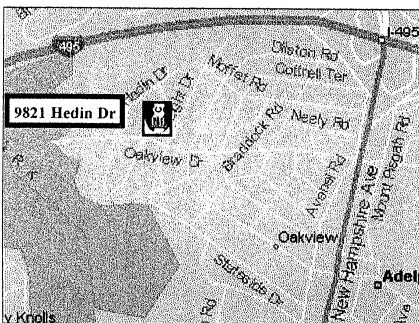

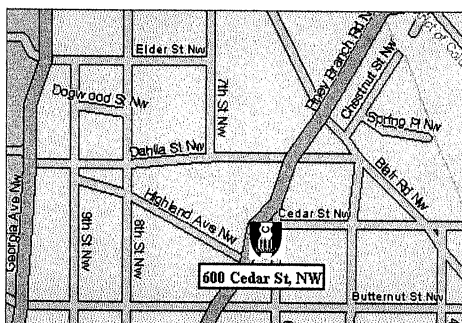

Who will be the next Atlantian Archer to win this honour and join the previous 6 Champions: Sir Tnek the Ainissest, Lord Lorenzo il Confuso, Henri La Graves, Muirghen Rhuadh, Lord Theodore Billingsley, and Earl Mika Longbow.

Bow Inspections will start at 10 am. A practice range and Royal round range will be available during the day.

The Competitions: The First Round of the Archery competition for the Championship will start at 11 am. Archers will face many and varied shoots this year. The new Champion will have to advance thru at least 16 shoots plus the final round, an Elimination Shoot as in past years. Crafted by the devious and clever mind of the current Champion, Baron Mika Longbow, shoots will include pop-up and 3-D targets. Rumors abound of dragons in the area, at least one of them flying. The Competition is open to all Atlantian Archers over the age of 18. Archers must choose the longbow, recurve or crossbow as their sole weapon for the whole event.

From Maryland: I-270 West to Frederick. South on route 15 to Point of Rocks Bridge. After crossing the bridge there is an immediate right turn, Lovettesville Road. Take Lovettesville Road for about 5 miles, you will go through the town of Lovettsville (all 4 blocks). Make a left on 287, Berlin Turnpike (7-11 will be on right). Go about 5 miles and make a left onto John Wolford Road (it is a gravel road). If you get to a traffic light you went too far. Turn around and John Wolford will be the first road on the right side 1 mile back. Go about 1.5 miles. (There are two sharp turns.) After the second turn you will see a red wood barn with a big white door on the right side of the road. Parking is just past the barn on the left.
