

Minutes of the Storvik Baronial Meeting

Exchequer - Tehair has sent off a letter applying to become our official Exchequer. We are still solvent - our current bank balance is \$736.52. \$150 has been sent to St. Andrew's for the Post Pennsic Revel. Chronicler -NTR. Herald - There were 2 submissions last month. Marshal - Fighting practices are going well. Light weapons are welcome at the Thurs. practices at Lady Aisha's. We had one new fighter authorize at Highland Foorde Melees. A&S - Quarterly report is in progress. Countess Alyson has some extra copies of back issues of T.I. Contact her if you're interested. She may give some to the Chatelaine. Demos - Storvik assisted Ponte Alto with a demo at the Fairfax County Fair recently. There will be a demo in Stierbach on 7/4. Anne of Corbridge is autocratting. It will be at the same site as last year. Storvik participated at a demo at JFK High School May 20-21. It was well advertised but poorly attended. Storvik made a total of \$2. Mistress Jaelle received a total of \$363.95 in checks and \$100 in gift certificates (which are to be used as prizes for A&S competitions) from the Border's demo last month. The money will be divided with Ponte Alto.

Old Business: We are still in search of a permanent, non-residential site for the Barony meetings. Tehair is going to do some calling around.

Brenna found someone who can assist her with the favours for Pennsic. They have a high-

tech sewing machine that can embroider them all for her automatically.

Kingdom Finances: There was much heated discussion as to what should be done with regard to King Michael's request for ideas on how to raise more money for the Kingdom. (You don'thave to be a Storviki to enter-as we said, there will be prizes for ALL winners!). We will also be holding our traditional Novice and Unbelted Fighters' Lists, so all you new fighters, come and show your mettle! (metal? whatever..) Come greet our brand new Baron and Baroness, Corun and Brenna!

FEASTING DEPT.: On Saturday evening, Igor Bear will serve up a hairy-chested Warriors' Feast of Beast, Bread, and Beer! This is a semi-provided feast - bring side dishes to share! We shall tap a keg or two for the feast, and non-alcoholic beverages will be provided to all throughout the event. (Maryland drinking age is 21, and ID will be checked).


