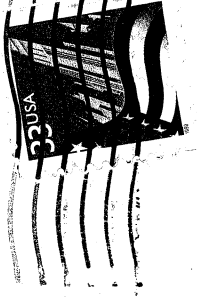

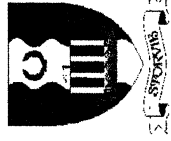

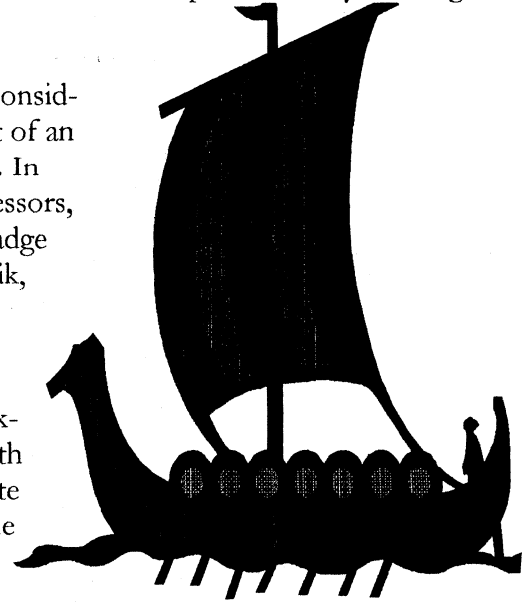

The Voice of the Herald is Heard

Her Excellency is considering the establishment of an arts and sciences order. In the days of her predecessors, Fevronia and Igor, a badge was registered to Storvik, viz.: Azure an Owl displayed and on a Chief Triangular Argent an Apple Gules [Blue background, a white owl with outspread wings, a white triangular divot over the owl, and on the divot,

a red apple], which was intended by her predecessors to be the badge of a baronial arts and sciences order. However, a name for the order was never registered.

As her pursuivant, I have already found that Order of the Snowy Owl has already been taken. However, to the best of my knowledge, both Order of the Owl and Apple and Order of the Owl of Storvik would be clear. The issue of what to name this proposed order is going to be brought up at the next couple of barony meetings.

From Richmond and points East: Go West on I-64 passing by Charlottesville, VA to I-81 SOUTH (Exit 56). Go South on I-81 passing by Roanoke, VA to I-11 (Exit 118). Go West on I-11 to stop light, make Right onto I-460 West. ** see below.

From Northern VA and points North: Go to I-66 West. Continue to the end of I-66 West and go South on I-81 (Exit 1). Go South on I-81 passing by Harrisonburg, VA to I-11 (Exit 118). Go West on I-11 to stop light, make Right onto I-460 West. **see below
