Knight Marshal: William said he is still acting as Knight Marshal because the paperwork for his successor, Jocelin, is still in process. It's time to renew our rental agreement with St. Andrew's Episcopal Church for fighter practice. We will not have fighter practice during the two weeks of Pennsic. We agreed to renew our fighter practice lease for another year with the added stipulation that pets are not allowed inside the church building. The formal transition between old and new Knight Marshals is expected to take place at Novice. *MoL:* The report is done for University. The University people were happy with the site. We had about 300 people at University. They have no bids yet for future Universities. Feast did not sell as much as we had expected; we lost a little money (\$3.50) on it. We had room between courses to do a little dancing. We still need to get the deposit check back from St. Andrew's Church.

Chatelaine: She has turned in her Chatelaine paperwork. She has one year from the date of the warrant to take the Chatelaine 101 class.

Exchequer: Account balance is \$4309.44. We just got \$244.16 from the fighter practice box for the last month. William said that the musicians and dancers have been contributing generously. Now fighter practice has more people than some small events! Gaspar also pointed out that during the post-University revel, no one was doing Troll, so he drove home, got the troll box, and spent the entire duration of feast creating troll sheets and collecting waivers and whatnot. Things need to be done differently. The Baronage apologized mightily for the oversight. In other post-University discussion, Gaspar said that we need to make sure that future event flyers mention the NMS. Some people were might-

ily annoyed because they didn't expect to pay another \$3. Orla said that we need to reschedule the St. Andrew's kitchen orientation so that we can use the kitchen for future events. Llyr will investigate.

Baron & Baroness: We went to Bright Hills' Merchant of Venice. It was a very pleasant event. At Sapphire we had a lovely view of the rapier events -- our first part of "grand procession" of Baronage. House Blackspear took the Heraldic Competition -- they got points for the dog. Rorik received a Coral Branch for teaching cribbage. Janina said that at University she volunteered to help with Troll, but didn't expect to do most of it. Rorik said that when the Baronial day shade is set up, we would like other Storviki to come join us. Thanks to all who have been helping to set up and take down the day shade. Blackspear and Cambion have agreed to wear the flashes. We are working on the rolls of people who will fight under the Storvik banner at Pennsic.

New Business (mostly Novice):

Rorik and Janina said that they will arrive at Novice on Friday and will camp in the wooded area. Llyr said that people who camp, as well as the cooks, should be able to park discreetly near their campsites.

Tirzah said that the Novice cook is willing to cook for >80 plus high table. We unanimously approved the expenditure of not more than \$600 for tent rental for Novice feast, similar to last year (Janina moved, Orla seconded). That way we have room for more feast attendees (up to 120). Tirzah also requested a cash advance for feast on behalf of the cook.

Llyr said he is donating \$20 worth of wood for the fire pit. William said that Raven (SCA name: Ludavico something) will be the MIC for Novice, and Janina said that Axel will run the youth fighting.

During Baronial Birthday, Janina said, the B&B will be

choosing Their Champions. We need to find the bottle that goes to the A&S champion traditionally. B&B are also open to award recommendations.

Additional B&B report: At the previous Baronial At-Home, whe had two new people, one an import from Ponte Alto. The next At-Home will be an Extended Version, starting at 1 p.m. on the Fourth of July and adjourning to Allen Pond Park for fireworks.

The officers present gave their reports. Despite a few minor issues with registrations/reservations, all went well with the University of Atlantia and University Feast.

Those present agreed to allow the spending of a sum up to \$600 (I think) for the purpose of renting a larger pavilion/canopy for Novice Tourney and to increase the number of feast seats from 80 to 120. The rest of Novice Tourney planning seems to be going well.

The meeting adjourned at 8:28 p.m.



This year's Storvik Novice Tourney will take place in the context of a social structure adapted from the forms of the European Middle Ages. These activities "recreate aspects of the life and culture of the landed nobility in Europe prior to 1600 CE." (SCA By-laws) That's right, the theme is 600 to 1600 CE! Since Novice Tourney is about the novices in the Society, we request that all non-novices show up as their persona of choice to give a wide display of what we do.

Martial Activities: Authorizations: Being only two weeks before Pennsic War 36, this is a great time to get authorized. Novices looking to participate in the Tourney, and those seasoned veterans trying out a new weapon style should arrive early, as we expect there are many who will need to be authorized. 

From the South: Make your best way to the Washington Beltway (I-495/I95) and US-50. Take US-50 toward Annapolis. Take the first exit from US-50 onto MD-704 toward Glenn Dale and Bowie. This is a RIGHT turn at the end of the off ramp. Follow MD-704 for about 1.5 miles when it becomes MD-450. Continue on MD-450. Turn LEFT onto MD-193 ENTERPRISE RD. Continue to follow MD-193 W. In less than .5 mi. turn LEFT onto BELL STATION RD. If you pass a fire station you've gone too far. End at 5626 Bell Station Rd, Glenn Dale, MD 20769-9120 US.

From the north: Make your best way to MD 295 (Washington Baltimore Parkway). Merge onto MD-295 S. Take the exit toward MD-193/GREENBELT/GODDARD SPACE FLIGHT CENTER. Take the ramp toward MD-193/COLLEGE PARK/UNIV OF MD/GLENN DALE/NASA. Turn LEFT onto MD-193 E/GREENBELT RD. Continue to follow MD-193 E for just over 5 miles. Small roll of teflon tape (used on all connections)

Portable hole

Part Numbers [in brackets] are from Lowes Hardware and cost approximately \$40 in 2005.

The brass cup or bowl needs a bit of work before it can be used. First a hole needs to be drilled in the bottom center just big enough to fit onto the reducer. If you have the tools to thread this hole that would be perfect. Then a bunch of holes need to be drilled in the sides of the bowl or cup evenly spaced around the bowl or cup. One suggestion is to start with 1/8" holes near the bottom and do 2 or 3 close spaced rows of holes, then leave an approximate 3/8" of space and go to a 3/16" bit and do another 2 or 3 rows of holes and so on up the side of the bowl or cup enlarging the bit size by 1/16" with each band. What this does is provides a Zippo like windbreak, allows oxygen to the flame, and some decoration.

You can go directly from the Char-Broil Hose to the Flare To Mip Half Union or you could have any length of gas hose between them. This isn't shown because a long hose costs a lot.

You can (should) cover the 20 lb. propane tank with a sturdy wooden box. This box should be sturdy enough to set on and should also have a way to anchor it to the ground. People tripping over it should not be able to knock it over easily.
