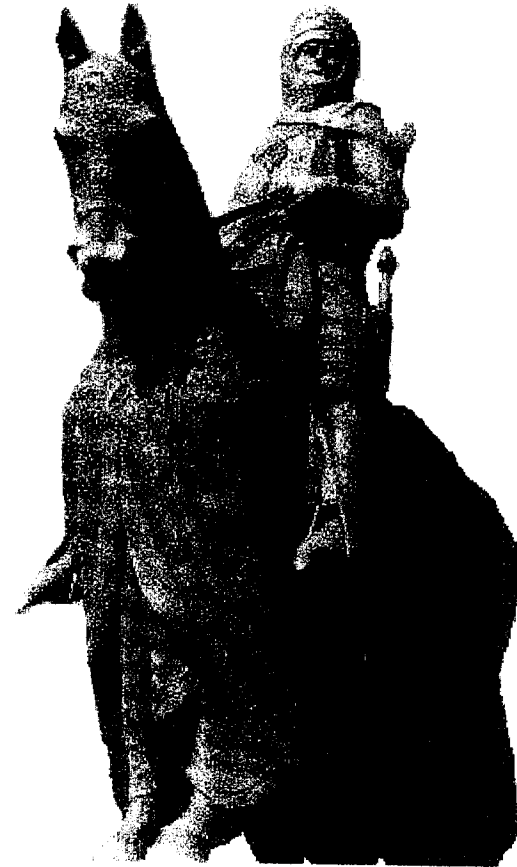

Greetings to the good People of Storvik, and all those who hear my words, from Frau Johanna von Sudeborn, Baroness of Storvik -

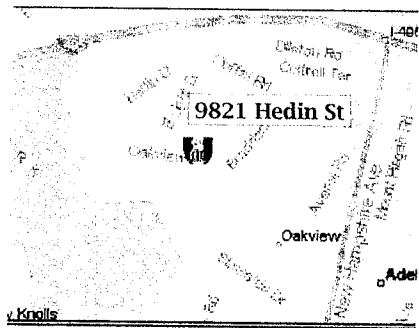

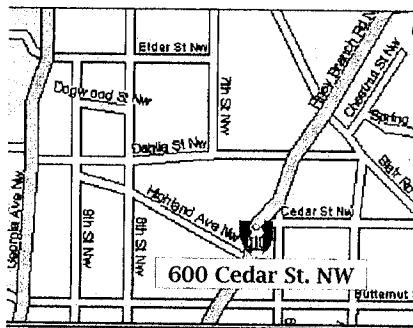
I am working on plans for Storvik camp at Pennsic, and this will be talked about at gatherings and on the list in the next 2 months. Please contact me should you want to camp with us.

Based on the responses I receive I will begin blocking out the course/demo lists.
