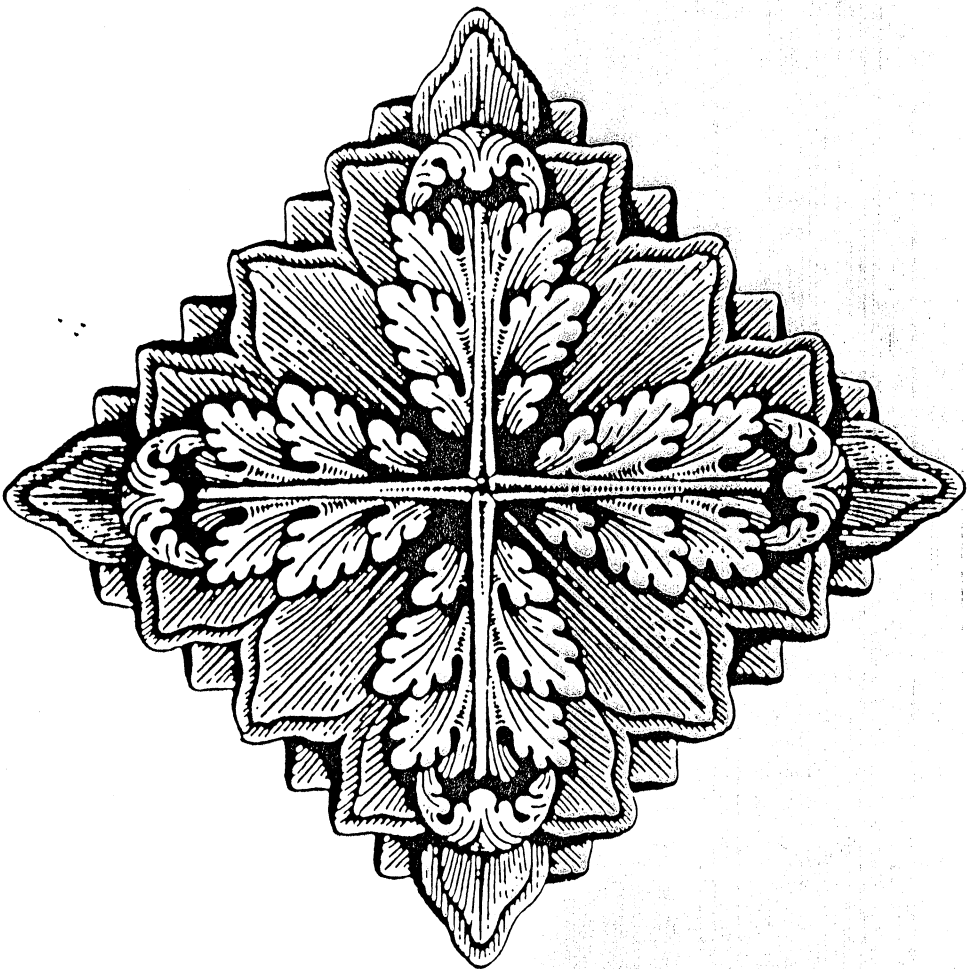

### OFFICERS REPORTS

**DIRECTIONS:** FROM POINTS SOUTH: Take I-95 north. Exit onto I-495 (Washington Beltway) to Rockville. Exit at Braddock Road west. (This is the first exit, so get over into the right lane quickly!) Go about 5.5 miles on Braddock Road. Turn right onto Roanoke Lane, an entrance to George Mason University. \*

FROM POINTS NORTH: Take your best route to I-495 (Washington Beltway), and exit at I-66 west. (The I-66 exit is at around 9:00 on the Beltway). Exit at 123 south (Exit 60). Go about 7.6 miles on 123. Turn left onto Braddock Road. Turn left onto Roanoke Lane, an entrance to George Mason University. \*(This is the first stoplight. There should be a gas station and University Mall on your right. At the fork in the road, bear right. (you should pass a lake on your left side, and the Patriot Center on your right. Sorry, parking is \$3 per car.

## NEWCOMER WELCOMING MEETINGS

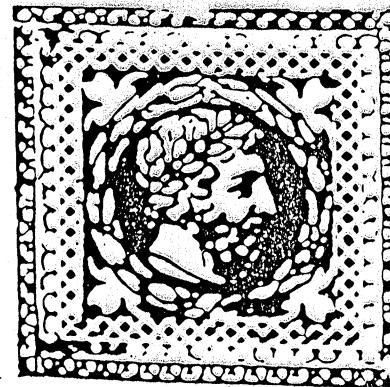

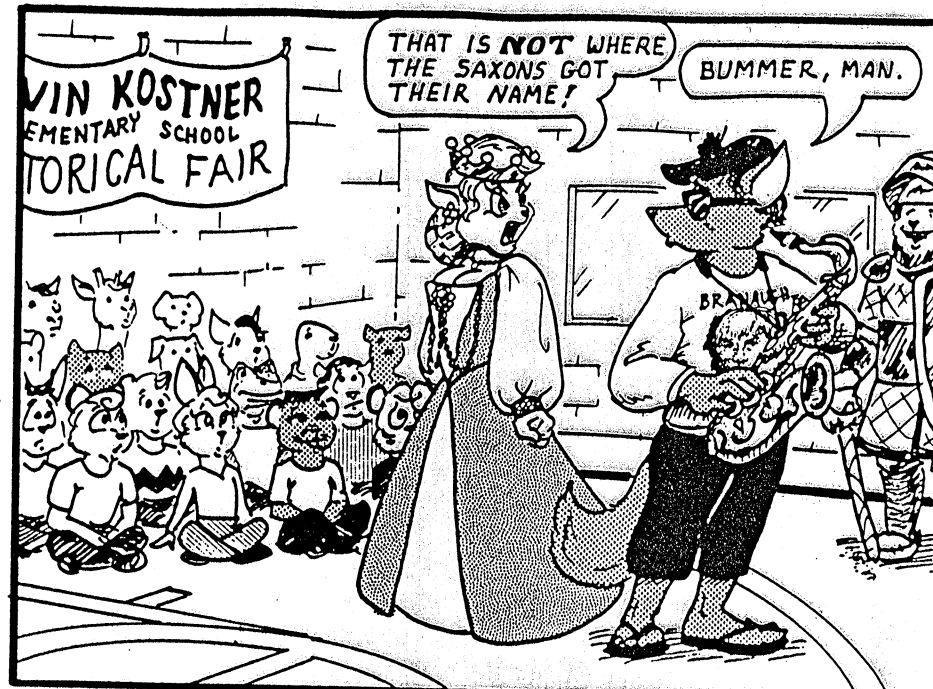
