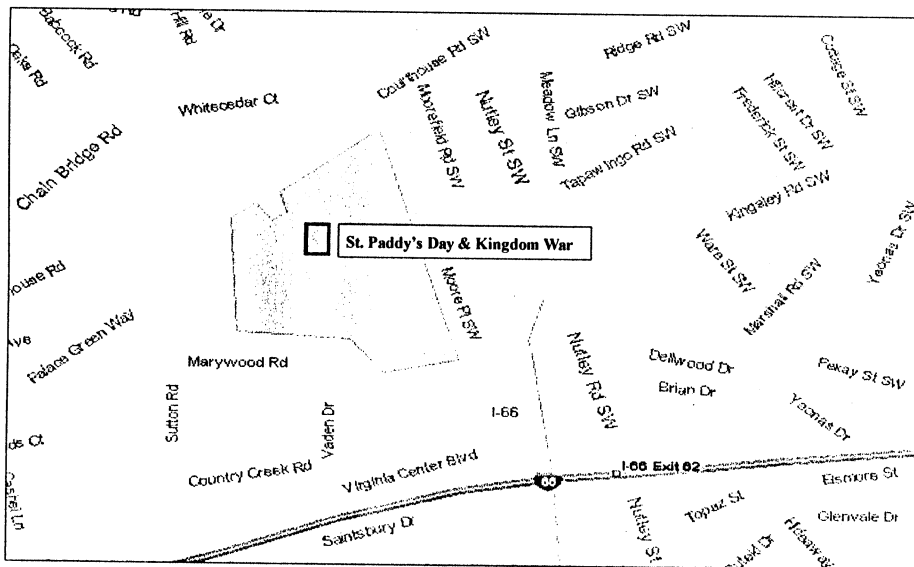
NOTE: Their Excellencies will be choosing Their armored combat and rapier champions at Bloodbath this year.
