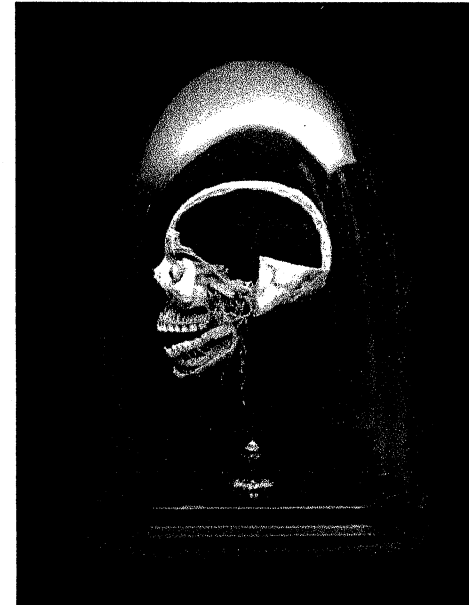

Officer Reports—

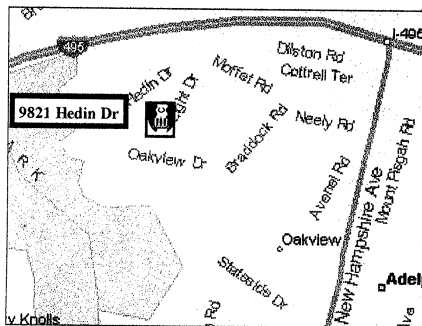
Baroness: Mary Grace and Havorth send their thanks for the Revel. Graham will be 10 on Valentine's Day.

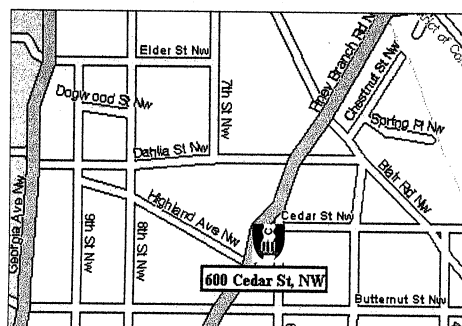
Arts & Sciences: Event report for Yule Revel went out (within 48 hours of last meeting, and 24 hrs of receipt of paperwork).

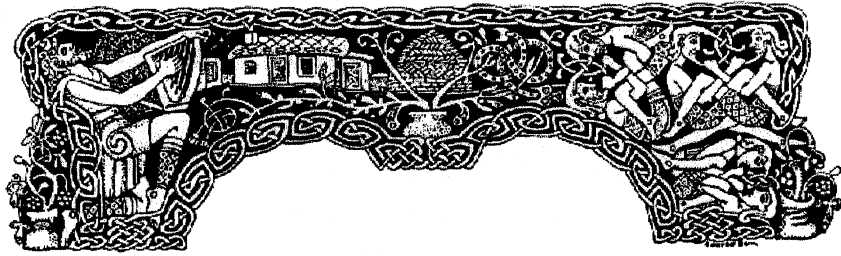
