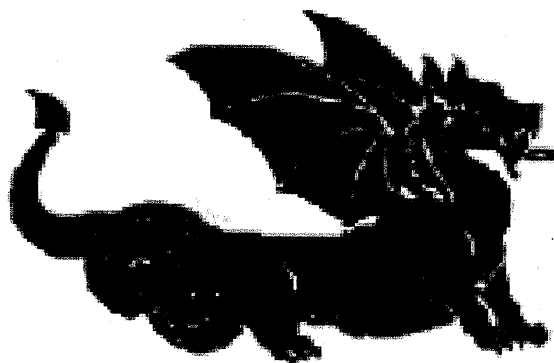

Knight Marshall: No practice on the 14th.

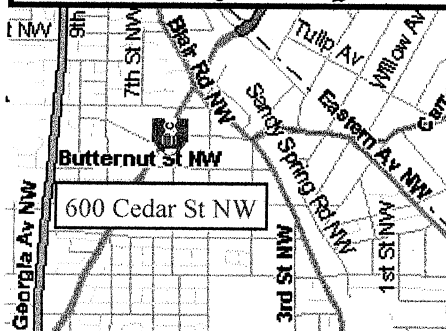
Minister of the Lists: Nothing to report.

Upcoming Events:

Investiture: March 26. Brenna, etc., visited site. Three merchants lined up. Meetings occurred for set-up. William agreed to pick up Johanna's tent early. Henry has decided that there WILL be fighting. No parking in parking lot of the firehouse; parking available on the side (see event announcement). Rorik will run Troll. People talked to cook. Incoming Baron & Baroness may be inflicting "Norman-ness". Brenna is taking pre-registration.

Novice Tourney: July 8-10. Forms turned in. Needs proof of Martialate for William. Needs copy of insurance to send to Marietta. Discussed sit-down feast possibility; no decision made (buffet likely, though)

Baronial Birthday: October 15. Have Marshall, MoL, Equestrians. Non-standard one day tourney planned (will check as to what is going on in Bright Hills). We need "keg permit" if we do this; bottles and cans preferred. Money on site should not be blatant, but merchanting will probably be okay. Will get alcohol and merchant permission in writing.

Post Pennsic Revel: Kira will be contacting Moira. Site to be considered later.

Old Business:

Storage: Store USA reserves half-spaces for nonprofits; this is being investigated. One in Crofton, one in Bladensburg.

Coronets: One is not currently accounted for; checked with church, but not there. Possible to borrow Igor and Fevronia's for Investiture. Maybe we should have a set of field coronets made. Possibility to duplicate the one we have.

Financial Policy: Should be put up for discussion & editing. Storvik's is considered generally good. Who gets to vote on use of Baronial funds? How can we prevent "vote-packing"? Hold this until next meeting. Exchequer to report. Suggestions & ideas go to Drekkar and Storvik list.

Order of the Faering: No heraldry current; moved & approved to give \$10 to the Heralds to approve our design. Badge for Faering is a rowboat or a boat with a sail. Why not do a background of white with three red bars. The boats are currently associated with Storvik in the minds of many people. These designs have no real possibility of conflict with anyone else's heraldry. Moved and approved for banner to be current design without the words; one vote against.

New Business:

Purchase of field coronets: Moved & passed to have these made & purchased. Sean to go to Gulf Wars and can pick these up; Ryryd to oversee.

New Chronicler: Arbogast announced he will be stepping down in February of next year.

Storvik Camp at Pennsic: Who will be Land Agent. Will we have a Storvik camp? There will be one, but it will not be BARONY of Storvik.

Storvik Sites at Events:

Sapphire Joust—Moved & passed to have one; Land Agent needed.
