The Order of the Lozulet of Storvik

The oldest of the awards and orders of the Barony of Storvik, one of the earliest known members of the order was Master Kay Delafleur who was inducted in May of 1978. The name was first registered as "The Order of the Lozulet" in July 1981 and changed to

"The Order of the Lozulet of Storvik" in April of 1982. The badge of the Order, "(Fieldless) On a lozenge Or within and conjoined to an annulet argent a drakkar proper under a full sail argent, charged with three pallets gules," was also registered in July 1981.

The Lozulet was originally an order to recognize those who excelled in service, arts and sciences, and fighting, but with the founding of the Company of the Silver Silkie and the Order of the Owl, the Lozulet now rewards those who perform continued and significant service to the Barony.

Stupid Bardic Tricks, Spring Edition

- Lady Teleri the Well-Prepared

You've probably heard of Geoffery Chaucer's The Canterbury Tales. Its Prologue contains a very famous description of spring. Here it is, with translation, from http://www.librarius.com/.

Whan that Aprill, with his shoures soote The droghte of March hath perced to the roote And bathed every veyne in swich licour, Of which vertu engendred is the flour;

Whan Zephirus eek with his sweete breeth Inspired hath in every holt and heeth The tendre croppes, and the yonge sonne Hath in the Ram his halfe cours yronne, And smale foweles maken melodye, That slepen al the nyght with open eye-(So priketh hem Nature in hir corages);

Thanne longen folk to goon on pilgrimages And palmeres for to seken straunge strondes To ferne halwes, kowthe in sondry londes;

And specially from every shires ende Of Engelond, to Caunterbury they wende, The hooly blisful martir for to seke That hem hath holpen, whan that they were seeke.

So, what's the Stupid Bardic Trick?

When in April the sweet showers fall That pierce March's drought to the root and all And bathed every vein in liquor that has power To generate therein and sire the flower;

When Zephyr also has with his sweet breath, Filled again, in every holt and heath, The tender shoots and leaves, and the young sun His half-course in the sign of the Ram has run, And many little birds make melody That sleep through all the night with open eye (So Nature pricks them on to ramp and rage)

Then folk do long to go on pilgrimage, And palmers to go seeking out strange strands, To distant shrines well known in distant lands.

And specially from every shire's end Of England they to Canterbury went, The holy blessed martyr there to seek Who helped them when they lay so ill and weak

You can sing the Prologue to the tune of Billy Joel's "For the Longest Time."

Now, it would help to know how to pronounce all that Middle English stuff, wouldn't it? Chaucer was writing before the Great Vowel Shift, which means his vowels would be pronounced more like those from the Romance languages (French, Spanish, Portugese, Italian). Also, all those final e's get pronounced.

Not enough? My Middle English is rusty, but you're welcome to it:

Whan Zeh-feer-oos ick weeth hees swit-eh brith Een-speer-ehd hath een ev-ry holt and hith Theh tehn-dreh crop-pes and theh young-eh son-neh Hath een theh Ram hees half-eh course ee-rohn-neh


And small-eh fool-es may-ken meh-low-die That slay-pen all theh nich*t weeth open ee (So pri-ken hem Nah-toor een heer cor-ah-gez); ** Thahn-ne long-en foolk to go-on on pil-grim-ah-gez And pahlm-air-es for too sake-en strawn-geh strawn-dez To fair-neh hal-wes, kowth een son-dree lon-des **

And spe-see-all-y from ev-ry sheer-es end-eh Of In-geh-lond to Caunt-er-boor-ee they wend-eh The hoo-lee blees-fool mar-teer for too sake-eh That hem holp-en whan that they were sick-eh

*Ch is the hard Germanic "ch" of "loch" or "Bach" ** An "eh" syllable went missing in each of these; it slurs into the word "in" that comes just after.


