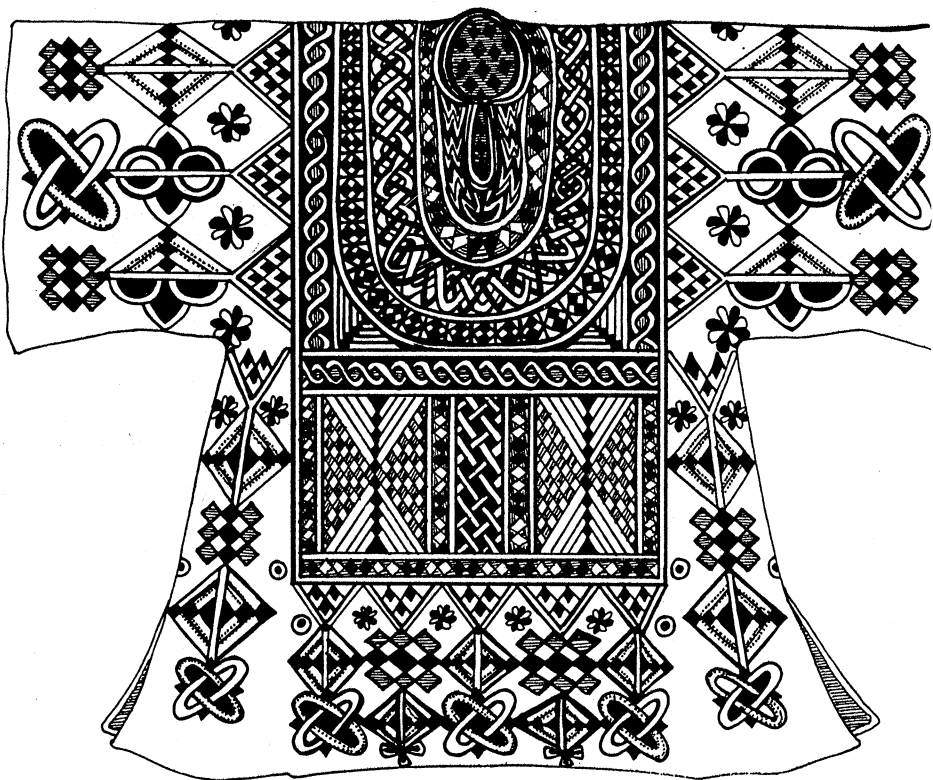

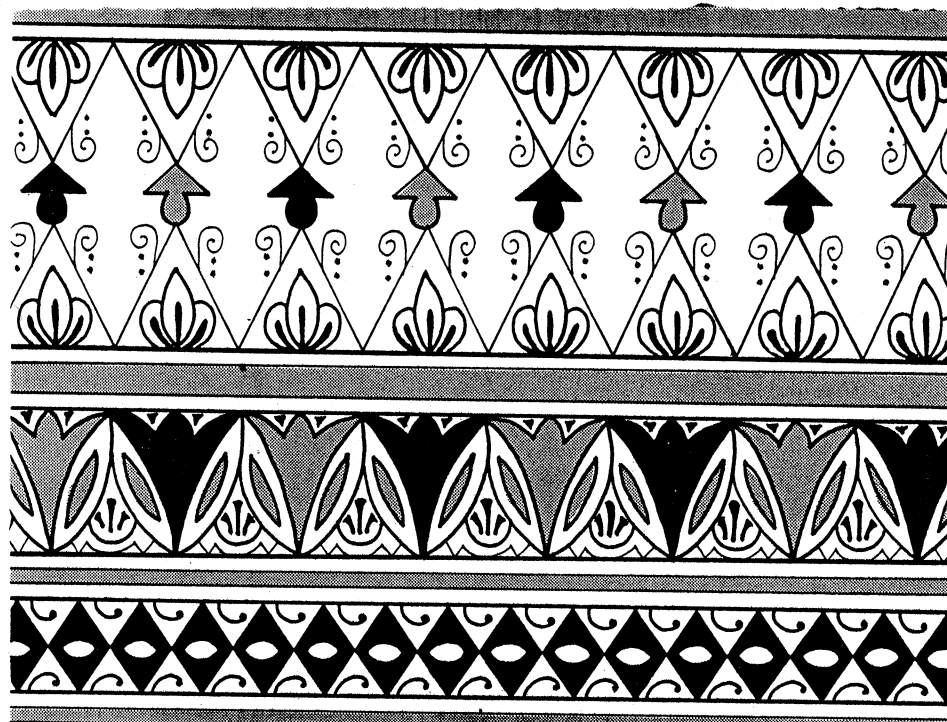

### OFFICER REPORTS

**Seneschal** - Nothing to report.

**Chatelaine** - Suggested an ad be put in the Drekkar.

**Chronicler** - Mass mailing to 210 area members has been completed. We are averaging four new subscriptions a month.

**Herald** - The new Laural meetings will be held at the same site as the Herald's meeting.

**Exchequer** - Correction to minutes of last meeting. Balance was \$1987.30. Yule, Drekkar, and other events have brought balance to \$2703.20. Need authorization for \$10 to purchase the new exchequer handbook. Will create a new form and handbook for autocrats to use. Need status on recent events and the site deposits for them.

**Marshal** - Two new authorizations. Will be conducting authorization's at Baron Champion Event. Ponte Alto has practice on Thursday's now. Roxbury Mill and Stierbach both have a practice site now.

**Demo** - See Upcoming Event Report.

**Minister of Arts and Sciences** - A form will be circulated throughout the Barony for referencing local talent. Suggestions from other officers included creating checkoff boxes for answers instead of fill in blanks.

### EVENT REPORTS
