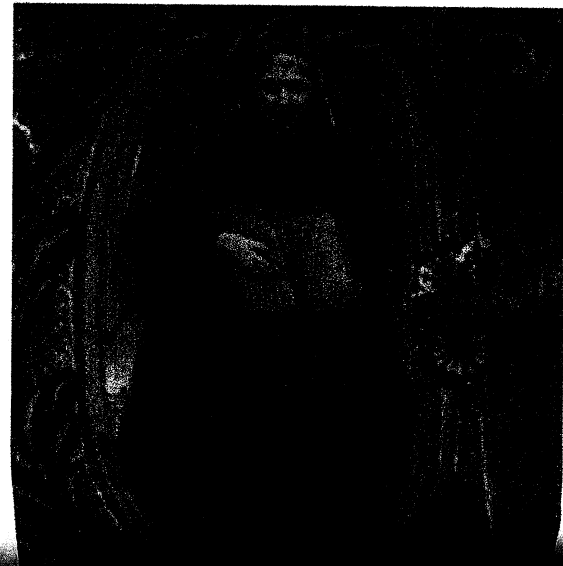

As I move on (and for those that know me, you also know it will not be to a religious order to contemplate my life), my time with you has been beyond price, one that will not soon be forgotten.

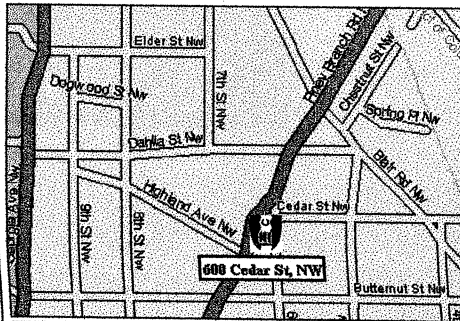
As I look to the future, I see the fair hand of a sister replace mine on the rudder. I can only ask that you treat her as well as you have treated me.

Two Paragraphs on Student Strikes

The first student strike goes back to 1229 at the University of Paris. There were no dorms or a campus as we know it. Some students had been thrown out by their innkeeper, and then came back with some more students and trashed the inn. The authorities were called in the students were chased down in the streets, beaten, thrown into the Seine, some were killed and wounded. The regents/ masters of the University protested all the way up to Queen Blanche, mother of the king to become Saint Louis. The situation was not resolved and the masters and students left town. There were other issues involved as to the relationship of the University to the church and state. Without a formal campus of buildings, it was a lot easier then for a teacher and his students to relocate and set up shop in another city.

In addition to the tangible loss of income from the absent faculty and students, there was also a great loss of prestige for Paris when the best-known university in Europe left and stayed away for some time. Things were not finally resolved until the intervention of Pope Gregory in 1231, who issued a Bull called , sometimes called the Magna Carta for education. The teachers gained independence in what they could teach; for instance, it was now acceptable to read, study, and teach Aristotle.
