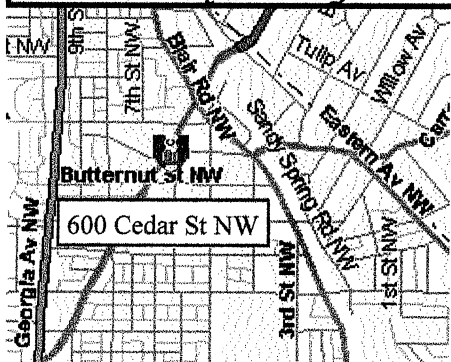

Her Excellency's Message

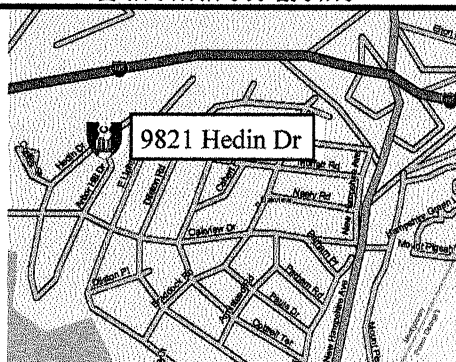
Greetings to the good People of Storvik, and all those who hear my words, from Frau Johanna von Sudeborn, Baroness of Storvik.

May 14/16: Bright Hills—Garb Wars: Siege of Orleans

In May of 1429, Joan of Arc came to the city of Orleans to defeat the English and raise that city's siege. Today, the Baron and Baroness of Bright Hills welcome all to declare themselves for Charles or Henry and to join that great conflict with needle and thread, rattan and blade, bow and arrow. All are encouraged to don early 15th century garb, as a prize is offered for best in garb of that period.

Heavy - Two teams will vie for the best time in taking the turell (fort), each alternating on attack and defense. Combat archers will be on the defensive side. Rapier - A debate in a tavern soon turns into a brawl and the watch must be summoned. Archery - a range and suitable target competitions will be offered.

Three categories of A&S competitions. First two have a 24 hr period (6PM Fri-6PM Sat) for their event; no prior preparation except as noted; documentation a plus, but not required. Garb War -Teams: Complete a garment/ensemble on site (material may be washed & dried to size). Embroidery-Solo: Enhance a garment or piece on site. Materials to be inspected prior to start. Novice - Display of previously constructed garb. Entrants no more than 2 years experience (SCA/mundane) in the medium entered (cloth, leather, etc). Documentation not required.
