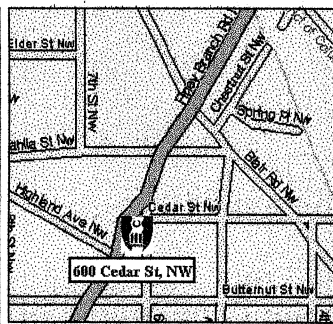

Storvik: May 7 to 9—Baronial Birthday and Baronial Champions

Once again our Barony feels the turn of the year. And so we will host our annual Storvik Baronial Birthday and Baronial Champions Tourney on May 7-9, 1999. While this is a camping event, for those arriving Friday night there are special conditions. Croom is holding an Astronomical Night on the 7th from 9pm until 12 Midnight. We may not have lights/fires or any other thing that might disturb the night vision during this time—including car headlights. We are invited to join this observation. The site opens at 4pm to allow our tents to be set up in time.

Authorizations will commence at 9am Saturday, followed by Tourneys at 11am. These and other Tournaments during the day will help to select the new Storvik Baronial Champions for Heavy and Rapier fighting, Archery, the Bardic Arts, and Arts and Sciences. There will be special competitions for Calligraphy and Illumination (Viking Theme), Heraldic display in use, as well as a rousing Hop-Scotch contest. These activities will be followed by Baronial Court (what a surprise!) and, of course, the feast. Later there will be a Bardic Circle around the camp fire.

Fees: On board \$11.00 / Off board \$4.00. Overnight Camping will be \$3.00/night additional for those reservations received on or before April 26. Children 12 and under will be half-price, 6 and under are free. Add \$1.00 to each fee after the 26th. Make checks payable to "Barony of Storvik/SCA Inc." Note: This is a public park, and we should not be collecting fees on site.

After lunch, we will terrorize Behnke Nurseries, which is one of the largest and best nurseries on the East coast. They have thousands of varieties of annuals, perennials, and woody plants, many of which are hard to find elsewhere. There is a fair selection of period plants among their stock, including period and non-period old roses; they're pricey, but the choice is wonderful and quality top-notch.

The day will end at Mistress Elien's, with a tour of her own antique and period roses, plus a Plant Exchange. Bring what you have extras of and take home what others bring. (You need not bring to be able to take, nor must things be period.)
