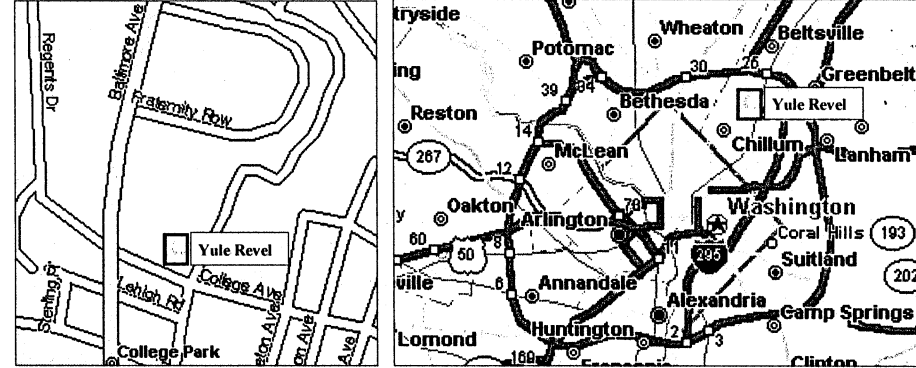
### Storvik: Yule Revel—January 1, 2000 (Cont.)
