



Atlantia/Barony of Bright Hills—Crown Tournament: November 1st to 3rd

The Barony of the Bright Hills invites all of Atlantia to join us in celebrating the Crown Tourney of their majesties, Cuan & Padraigin at Rocks 4H Camp, near Belair, MD. In addition to the traditional tournament and pagentry, other activities such as archery, childrens programs, and of course, shopping will be available.

His Majesty plans a Curia prior to feast on Saturday.

The Bright Hills cooks guild is planning two separate feasts. The 3 remove, above the salt feast will be limited to 104 seats. The below the salt feast is planned for 50 gentles (plus or minus) and will be served al fresco, weather permitting.

A separate childrens dinner and party will be held from 6pm to 10pm. Belated trick-or-treating is planned, so bring that left over candy. Childrens programs are not a baby sitting service. Parents are expected to sign children in and out and to donate a minimum of one-half-hour of their time. Unsupervised children found playing in the stream, or too near the list field, will be taken to heralds point and their parents summoned.

The camp offers plenty of space for tent camping, or cinder block dorms which have showers and flush toilets. Bunk space is available on a first come first serve basis. A block of 20 rooms has been reserved at the Best Western Inn, at the intersection of I-95 and Route 24 for \$60/night. Rooms must be reserved prior to 10/13/02 to ensure the special price. Persons needing handicapped accessible rooms can request them at the discount rate, however, there are only a few available. Call the Best Western at 800-408-4748 and ask for the SCA special rate.

Generous parking is available near the camp entrance, and at the dorms. NO PARKING WILL BE PERMITTED IN VISUAL LINE WITH THE LIST FEILD. Handicapped parking will be available near but out of sight of the field.

Merchants are always welcome. There is no extra fee, but table space under the pavilion may be scarce due to kingdom needs.
