I hope you are all recovering from the storm and rains, and that you and yours are well. Fall is now upon us, 'though I can scarcely believe it.

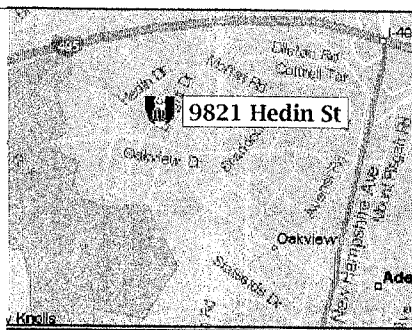

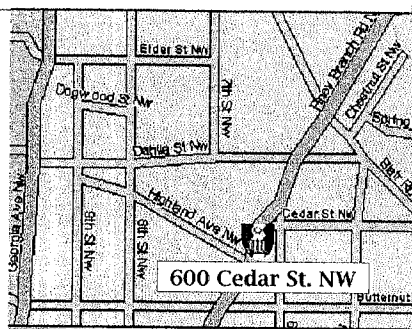
