

Statement from Karl and Samara.

Greetings to the populace of the Noble Barony of Storvik from Karl & Samara. As some of you have heard, we have made our intent known to become your next Baron and Baroness. We are sending this missive so you will have some reference as to our SCA background and our thoughts on what we bring to the Barony and the office of Baron and Baroness.

We started in the SCA back in 1979 in the, then, Principality of Drachenwald. We lived in the Principality for four years. While we were there we each held several Offices. For a short time Samara was the A&S Officer for the Shire of Knights Crossing. She then became its Seneschal and submitted the paperwork for the first Shire to become a Barony in Drachenwald. Later she moved up to become the Principality Seneschal. While she was the Principality Seneschal, it was her priority to visit every group there and help them set up armoring factories and A&S/newcomer information nights. Holding offices was not the only service that she performed for Drachenwald. She was also the secretary for the Principality Collage of Heralds and she Autocrated several events to include a Principality 12th Night and Coronet Tourney. For her service to the Principality she was given an Award of Arms and for her service to Knight Crossing she was made a member of the Order of the Wheel. As a new member of the SCA, Karl was the Shire of Knights Crossing's Deputy Herald and a member of the College of Heralds. Later he became the Marshal of the group after it became a Barony. During the last year and a half in Drachenwald, he was the Principality Knight Marshal. As well as the offices that he held, he was also the guild master for the Scribes Guild. Karl held the honors of being the Champion for the Barony of Knights Crossing and the 1st Princess's Champion, as well as one of the first Lieutenants of the Black Dragon Guard, all these being by right of arms. For his service he was made a member of the Order of the Silver Guard for his fighting and teaching of the heavy fighting arts, thus receiving his Award of Arms.

Next we moved to Atlantia and lived in the Barony of Tyr-y-Don. Samara held the office of Chronicler for a time and it was then that she named the newsletter the Nod-y-Ryt, Tyr-y-Don reversed, and the name is still in use almost 2 decades
