Officers' Reports:

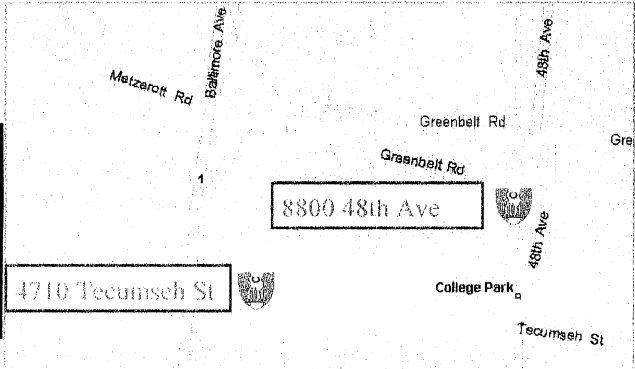
Baron and Baroness: Attended Lochmere's event; cool tourney.

Financial Policy:
