

Pointless War IV October 11-14

The site this year is the Horns Point Environmental Laboratory, at the mouth of the Choptank River in Cambridge, Maryland (Barony of Bright Hills).

There will be heavy and light weapons competitions combat scenarios, as well as archery competitions. There will be an Arts and Sciences competition with War Banners and Field Heraldry. It will be judged on the field, during the battles. It is a group competition, with the group showing the most effective overall use of heraldry during the battles as the winners. The winning group will be announced in Court.

This is an unimproved site, but portable water, portajohns, and showers are available on site. Ground fires are not permitted, but tiki tourches are exceptable. The site is part of the University of Maryland and is discreetly wet. The site opens at 4 p.m. Friday and closes at 1 p.m. on Monday.






