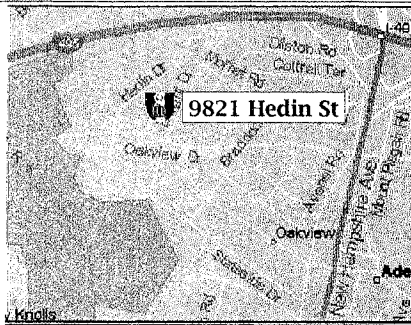

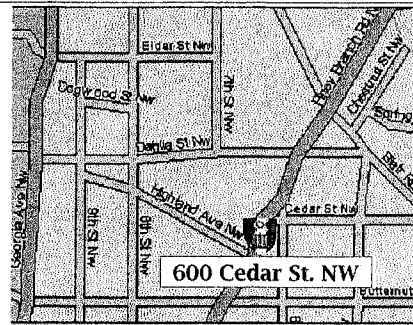

Each Bard should have 2 pieces prepared, one of which shall be in period style documented. Both pieces must contain some mention or theme concerning a drinking vessel. Artifact Chalice Cometition: Artisans shall compete in a Challengers. Competition for the right to face the Chalice Artisan. The winner of that competition shall become Chalice Artisan, and may compete under the title next year. The competition theme is "A Lady's Pleasure" . things that are enjoyed by ladies in period.
