

September 10 to 12: Barony of Lochmere Masters of Defense

Do you have what it takes to be a Master of Defense? Come to the Barony of Lochmere on the weekend of September 10-12 and put your skills to the test for all to see! Based on the activities of the London Masters of Defense, a guild of martial arts instructors established by Henry VII, this tourney will challenge the participants to prove themselves in both armored combat and rapier combat.

The tournament itself is composed of two phases: an open phase where fighters can compete in both armored and rapier combat and then the elimination phase where the best of the best are pitted against one another to determine the final victor. In order to be considered for advancement to the elimination phase, a fighter must have at least 2 victories each in 2 different forms of rapier and 2 different forms of armored combat (8 total victories).
