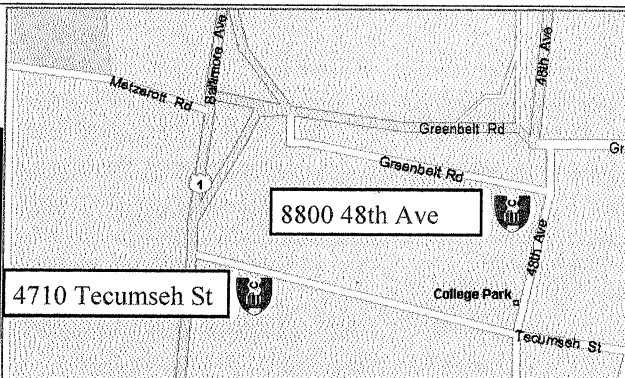

Set in Spain, but based on the activities of the London Masters of Defense, a guild of martial arts instructors established by Henry VII, this tourney will challenge the participants to prove themselves in both armored combat and rapier combat.

Join Their Majesties King Janos of Cyddlain Downs and Queen Rachel Wallace as they invest the new Baronage of Lochmere; stay for the tournament and feast.

The fighting theme for the day is Bear-pit. Open lists for both rapier and armored will be available all day. In addition, lists for specified forms will be run at the same time.
