But that is but one of the many stories that are now told of our fighters. There was the great charge against the Eastern flank that sent that army scattering. There was the brave taking of the bridge by Sir Xenaphon who led a contingent of Storvik fighters against the East and was stopped halfway only by the word of Galmr. T here were the War Points in archery taken by Andrew Roriksson, the youngest of Storvik's archers. We are proud of all of you.

So gallantly and proficiently did our warriors fight, that many compliments were given us regarding their prowess. It was with great honour that we did, at Atlantian Court the day of the Field Battle, initiate a Fighting Order within the Barony. Their Majesties did allow us to hold court within Their court, and it was there that Master Malcolm MacMalcolm, Lord Oswulf the Grey and Lord Sean Delamare were inducted as the first recipients of the Order of the Silver Selkie. Master Malcolm was inducted for his long and continuous service to Storvik in the training of others and skill on the field. Lords Oswulf and Sean were inducted for efforts above and beyond what could possibly be expected of anyone under the best of circumstances in training and armoring anyone who asked assistance regardless of their affiliations in or out of the Barony. The esprit de corps that they have engendered in the fighters both in Storvik and the outlying areas was very evident at Pennsic. This Order has been established to encompass not only Heavy weapon fighters, but also rapier and combat archery. Vivat to all who have contributed to the welfare of Storvik and Atlantia.

We are most grateful to Sir Strykar for letting us use a badge he had created back in the Dim Early Days of Storvik. It's original intent was as an award for the Shield Wall of the Barony of the Storvik, but since it never saw use, he was glad to let us use it and the name for our new Fighting Order. So you will know it when you see it, the badge is as follows; Azure, a fess wavy argent, surmounted by a sealion erect counter-changed, between four annulets in saltire argent.

Upon returning from The Great War, tired, dirty, ready for air-conditioning and a good party, the Post Pennsic Revel was upon us. There were many deserts, stories, and much dancing and rejoicing that we were once again in the lap of luxury (and just where was the air-conditioning?). We wish to thank our Autocrat Catriona Beannshean, all who made the wonderful desserts, the musicians (the ad-hoc Storvik Doumbek and Harp Corps), the dance masters and story tellers.

Perrin reported that he is writing a booklet of information on Melee fighting, and has received much positive feedback on the current draft. He would like to print this to distribute to fighters both in and outside of Storvik, and requested funding for the cost of the paper. (Free printing has been arranged.) \$35 expenditure approved unanimously.

Brenna reported that the Baronial order of the Silver Silky for fighting has been established. The name and the badge to be used have been previously registered. As the king returned homeward, he overtook the enemy at York; but his main army was behind at Chesterford. There was great slaughter made; and the king was so wroth, that he would fain return with his force, and lay waste the land withal; but when the council of the Northumberians understood that, they then abandoned Eric, and compromised the deed with king Edred.

The Barony of Storvik invites you to come and join us in a recreation of Edred's campaign against Eric Bloodaxe. On October 26, 1996, at Patuxtant River Park (Croom), one of the battles of Edred of England and Eric Bloodaxe will be fought. On one side, Norse and Danes. On the other, the English and Danes. Once the warriors are divided into armies, each army will acclaim (elect) it's King. Weapons and shield forms are limited to those known in 10th century England, Ireland, and Scandanavia (i.e., round or kite shields, and single-handed sword or axes, spears, viking two-handed [long] axes. 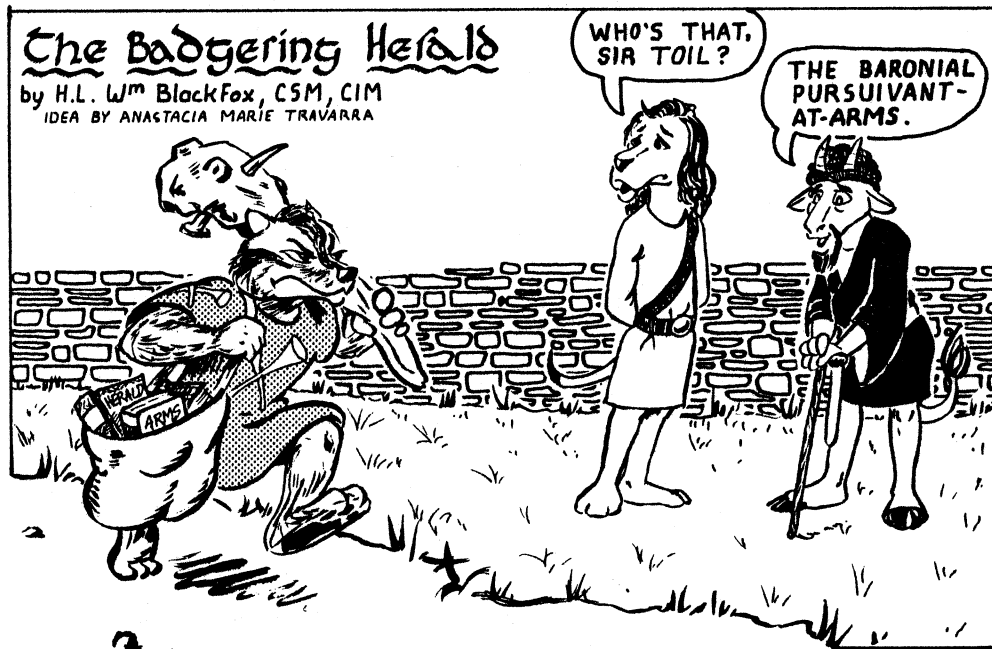
