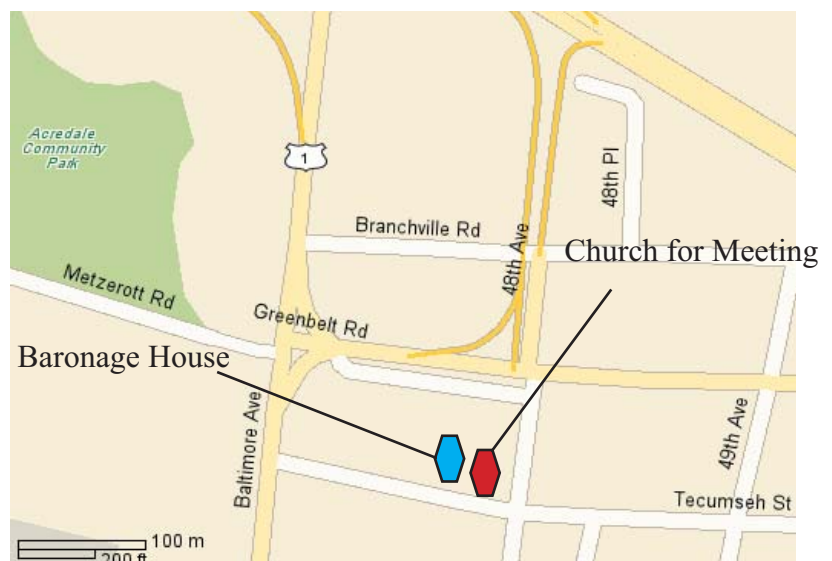

Officer Reports: **Chronicler:** Barony and populace have saved \$250 since electronic Drekkar was launched. **Web Minister:** No Report. **Exchequer** (by proxy): Balance around \$3,800 before PPR. Made a profit on PPR. BBday should be simple, since Llyr can cosign checks and is autocrat. Payment on Coronets still pending. **A&S:** PPR went well. Baroness Catherine is starting A&S moments during fighter's practice. **Seneschal:** Need a policy on giving away Known World Handbook to newcomers, books not yet ordered, previously approved to buy 25 volumes for initial issue. **Baronage:** After two years of honorable service the B&B have decided not to ask for a second term. Nominations are open immediately, to close at the next meeting, with a polling to follow. **Old Business:** Gaspar needs to be reimbursed for the Takoma Park Demo registration, which though we backed out is still an expense. Call for receipts for PPR. **New Business:** BBday ~ some issues with feast, but going forward with \$8 per person cost with an 80 person limit. Equestrian is on ~ looking into rental horses. Make your best route to the eastern side of the 495/95 DC Beltway. Take Exit 11 Pennsylvania Avenue(Rt 4) toward Upper Marlboro. Follow Pennsylvania Avenue to Rt. 301 Crain Highway, take Crain Highway south toward Richmond. In approximately 5-6 miles, look for Croom Road on your left . Take Croom Road approximately 4-5 miles to a left turn onto Croom Airport Road, and follow Croom Airport Road into the parking lot.
