Baron/Baroness:

Had At Home. Had a new guy, who has also talked to Chatelaine. Would like to make new banners for the Barony to be done by Novice. Their basement is available as a space to make banners but need help to know what to buy. Will try to price supplies by next Barony meeting. Will be at Performer's Revel. Andrew will be graduating in a month and a half. There will be a Storvik encampment at Sapphire Joust. Name of encampment for registration purposes is "Storvik". Going to be at St. Aiden's event and will be loaning the event the Baronial Dayshade. Will not be going to Coronation or Crown.

MOL:

Nothing to report

Herald:

Nothing new; needs to do reports. Would like to do a heraldry night at fighter practice, but is working out the logistics. Is willing to help with announcements at St. Aiden's if needed.

Exchequer:

Have revised financial policy; will be voted on later in meeting. Dun Carraig is in contact regarding Novice/Challenge. 1st Quarter report is due at end of month.

A&S:

Performing bardic circle at Ambra's happened over the weekend, no one at the Barony meeting went. There will be a Poeta Atlantiae competition at Sapphire. Performers' Ensemble practices will be on hiatus after this Tuesday. More information on the practices will be available in the fall.

Lots of "one off" things are going on. A couple of people went to the Walters for the calligraphy exhibit and lecture. Also of note there is an illumination exhibit at the National Gallery of Art. Patches is still teaching knitting. EGGS is still on hold, but will be back in by April of 2010. A&S in general is scaling back until after Pennsic. Banners are a priority until Novice.

Knight Marshall:

Fighter practice is going well. Hall was closed one night this month per agreement with Church. Need a replacement by Novice Tourney. \$270 in donations

Seneschal:

We've agreed to combine Storvik Novice Tourney with Dun Carraig's Challenge of the Heart due to a scheduling conflict. We have a new Minister of Minors since Acelina Le Dragon was warranted last month.

Events

Performer's Revel – 17 paid reservations. Igor is collecting food and has a goat. Usually good food, homemade bread and butter. Really low stress. Axel & Jeanmarie are coming. Will turn in receipts for food- does not need an advance. Since event is pre-reg only do not need a check for troll. The Poeta Atlantiae is sponsoring a spring poem challenge.

St Aiden's – (Report from Abel via phone) May 9th. All staff lead positions filled. Will be using Baronial Dayshade but would appreciate a few extra tents for shade. Mundane pop ups are okay for the purpose. Johanna needs a \$200 cash advance for gate. Cost is \$12. Abel has posted to the Merry Rose and will be publicizing more. Tirzah has no reservations at this time. St. Aiden's will be doing authorizations and marshalling.

Fairie Fest Demo – May 16&17. Beatrice is moving that weekend but will be available on Sunday. Tatiana will be on-site coordinator. Planning a bookmark giveaway/fundraiser. Will be having work nights in the coming weeks. Will bring all supplies to fighter practice on April 13. Bookmarks will be given away for free with calligraphy or illumination on them. We will be requesting a donation in return. Need people to punch holes and tie strings. Volunteers for the demo need to contact Beatrix to get in for free. Would like to use Baronial Dayshade. There is a parking fee per car, but don't know what it is.

Zoo Demo – June 12th. Actual demo starts at 6, but set-up is early afternoon. Three Left Feet dancers will be there. Rorik will talk to Syr Richard regarding the need for a marshal for the fighting. Stephan will MOL the fighting.

Novice Tourney/Challenge of the Heart – Flyer has been sent in to get something in the Acorn. Dun Carraig wants to do a Pas. Tirzah and Baronessa Gracia will be co-head cooks. Tirzah offered to cook a dinner for the Novice event staff on Friday, April 17 so we can have a joint planning meeting.

Post Pennsic Revel – Church is available, and deposit check was issued. Samara will be cooking the side board. Brenna is trying to get the Middle Eastern community to help decorate.

Old Business

Financial policy was approved. Teleri will send to Kingdom for Review.

Shed proposal –

While the proposal was approved at the last Barony meeting, there was some confusion by a couple of people about the legality of the proposal. After consulting with the Northern Regional Seneschal the proposal was revised. Now Storvik will be renting the plot of land that the shed will go on from Frederich and Tirzah, for the sum of \$1 per month (paid on an annual basis). Tirzah will be donating the rock to go under the shed, and Storvik will be buying the shed. Tirzah was approved up to \$1,500 to purchase the 8X10 shed and shelves, and will provide receipts. The shed will be the property of the Barony and will be added to the Storvik Inventory and depreciated. Teleri said that the forms are not a problem since Excel does all the work on that for her.

Tirzah requested the purchase of a “For Deposit Only” stamp to make the reservation process easier. A vote was taken and she was given approval for “no more than \$50” to buy two stamps, one she will keep and the other will go in the Troll box. The stamps will include the Storvik account information on it.

Some donations were made to Iron Key by ??? Segehart volunteered to take them to Fighter Practice. Reminder that we need to find a new Iron Key Officer.

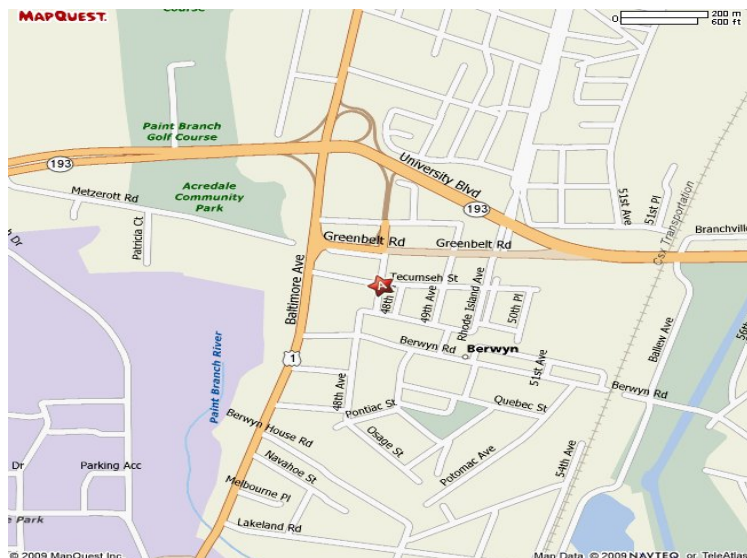
