Chatelaine:

Baron & Baroness:

Janina says she will be attending the Gathering of Guilds. There is a Reenactors' yard sale coming up in a couple months. The baron and baroness will be out of town at the end of the month but will return in time for the next barony meeting. Rorik is going to Estrella. Baron & Baroness At-Home and the At-Home on Boxing Day were well-attended.

Minister of Arts & Sciences:

Beatrix reports that Scribal night went well, the new sewing night went well and was well attended, and a number of Storvikii did well at Kingdom 12th Night.

Herald:

Patricia is looking for deputy heralds and is interested in offering a monthly herald night at fight practice.

Exchequer:

Teleri says the 4th Quarter reports and Domesday report are finished, as is the event report for Storvik Baronial Birthday. In 2008, \$2,129.20 was collected at the weekly fight practice. The Barony currently has \$6,497.64. It is important to make sure financial people's paperwork is up to date. Teleri is looking for a deputy Exchequer.

Minister of the Lists:

Stefan is looking for another MOL for Storvik. They must take the MOL class and assist at two events to be qualified.

Chronicler:

Nothing to report.

Quartermaster:

Kunigunde is looking for someone to take over the guartermaster duties.

Seneschal:

Orla reports that the Knight Marshal is stepping down and needs a replacement. The Kingdom is looking for people to run Kingdom-level events. We might think about running a Kingdom-level event next year.

Regarding the polling - \$121.41 was spent on the polling, with envelopes donated by Tirzah. The polling was mailed to approximately 116 people; 5 were returned by the post office. The polling must be post-marked by Friday the 16th.

Regarding dishes – a few were broken at the 12th Night feast; the rest will be going back to Orla. Tirzah is pricing new dishes from Target for high table and found some good ones for about \$120. Janina moved to allocate \$200 for new dishes; Beatrix seconded; this was unanimously approved.

Event Planning:

We have sites for all our events this year: Croom on May 9 for Saint Aiden's; Croom on June 20 for Novice Tourney; Croom on Sept 12 for Storvik Baronial Birthday.

Fees for Croom have changed, to be based on the number of people camping.

Performer's Revel:

April 18, pre-reg only. Baronial Bardic Championship will be held at this event.

Saint Aiden's:

May 9 - The site fee is \$200 for Saturday only for Saint Aiden's event plus \$120 estimated for camping. This is a fighter-friendly event. Head cook is Boska. Abel will provide a revised budget in February.

Faerie Fest demo:

May 16-17, two-day event with cabins – must be pre-registered. Beatrix is coordinator for this event. She has sent in a request for cabin space but hasn't heard back.

Novice Tourney:

June 20 - Victoria has volunteered to autocrat.

Post-Pennsic Dessert Revel:

August 15 – Brenna will autocrat. She wants to use a Middle-Eastern theme and is still looking for a head cook. Valentinus volunteers to cook.

Storvik Baronial Birthday:

September 12 – Kunigunde will autocrat. She was told to get last year's budget from Teleri, and a number of ideas were suggested regarding the theme.

No new business.

The meeting was concluded at 7:49PM.
