Minutes of Monthly Business Meeting, May 10, 2009

Attendees: Stefan of Cambion, Janina Krakowska, Sorcha Prechain, Patricia of Trakai, Teleri the Well-Prepared, Orla Carey, Tirzah MacCrudden, Kunigunde, Victoria, Baska, Abel Brem It is now required to collect SCA membership numbers from attendees to ensure that everyone voting on issues at the meeting is a member.

Meeting began 7:11pm.

Officer's Reports

<u>Chatelaine</u> – Tirzah reminds us there are a couple of demos coming up. At least one newcomer has been authorized to fight at St. Aiden's event. A party of four new children and one new adult attended the event, the children with youth combat-legal swords.

<u>Chronicler</u> – Nothing to report.

<u>MoL</u> – Stefan says there were 15 new and renewing authorizations; Kunigunde and Tirzah assisted at St. Aiden's event.

<u>Baroness</u> – Baron and Baroness attended Performer's Revel; Baroness attended St. Aiden's. B & B intend to be at Faerie Fest demo and Sapphire Joust with dayshade, Highland River Melees and Guppy Gala at the zoo, but might have to miss On Target. His Excellency's health will determine how many events they can get to.

Herald – Patricia says the quarterly report is in. She discussed heraldic needs with Dun Carraig herald for Novice/Challenge. Requests the assistance of as many loud-voiced people as possible to be field heralds, is going to request a consult table for the event.

Meeting Minutes from May 10, continued

<u>Exchequer</u> – Teleri says the quarterly report is in. We are down \$913.49 in the first quarter because we made purchases but had no events to provide income. Kingdom is mostly pleased with our financial policy and made suggestions. Storvik currently has \$5584.15 including site deposits and at end of Quarter 1 had \$3761.62 in the bank.

<u>Seneschal</u> – Vlad won Crown Tourney and we should have both sets of Royals for Novice Tourney.

Knight Marshal - Joscelin says the new Knight Marshal will be Lady Constanza, who has already been approved by the KMoL.

<u>A&S</u> – Sorcha says the Scribal Guild is working on bookmarks as a fundraiser for Storvik at Faerie Fest. Sorcha will be holding a brewing competition at Sapphire.

Event Reports

<u>Performer's Revel</u> – Baroness says the new Baronial Bard will be Winn. There were 30-some attendees and the profit was \$103.93.

St. Aiden's Melee College – Abel says there were 113 attendees and about \$768 profit to be split between the Kingdom and Barony, as the Order of St. Aiden does not keep any money.

Upcoming Events

<u>Faerie Fest demo</u> – Sorcha reports that Tatiana will be managing the demo for Beatrix.

Novice Tourney and Challenge of the Heart – Victoria is still working on a name and is having trouble getting in touch with Dun Carraig autocrat. Stefan volunteers to MoL. Victoria brought updated budget but has no budget from Dun Carraig for their part of the event. Needs tables, chairs and day shades. Break-even point is about 174 people. We expect Atlantian Royals to attend. Patricia talked to the Dun Carraig herald and agreed that each barony's heralds would cover their respective courts. Each team for the Pas is supposed to provide their own herald, so that should be covered. It was moved and seconded to approve the budget. This was unanimously approved.

<u>Post-Pennsic Revel</u> – Brenna says in the past about 30 people have brought desserts. Samara is cooking and Boska has volunteered to help. It has a Middle-Eastern theme and will start about 3pm. There will be dessert contests for period and non-period desserts. Tirzah volunteers to be Troll. It was moved and seconded to approve the budget. This was unanimously approved.

Storvik Baronial Birthday – Kunigunde is autocratting. Budget was discussed. Break-even point is about 115 adults. We expect Atlantian Royals to attend. Tirzah is head cook and requests to add \$50 to the budget for the sideboard. With that change, it was moved and seconded to approve the budget. This was unanimously approved.

Old Business

<u>Dishes</u> - Tirzah handled buying plates, bowls and platters for 12 people at high table. Orla donated water glasses. Utensils are still needed.

<u>Storage shed</u> – Orla says the shed is being purchased this week and there will be a shed-raising party Sunday May 17 at 1pm at Orla's and Tirzah's home. Items still at the storage unit will be moved into the new shed.

<u>Banners</u> – Baroness is working on new silk banners and is hoping someone can donate framing supplies for stretching the silk while it's being painted. The budget is about \$100-160 depending on how much paint is

needed. She is hoping to get this project done before Novice Tourney. Orla moved to buy supplies not to exceed \$160; this was seconded and unanimously approved.

New Business

<u>Misc expenses</u> – Teleri moved we reimburse Johanna for supplies for the troll box at approximately \$4. This was seconded and unanimously approved.

It was moved to reimburse Teleri for copying and postage at approximately \$6. This was seconded and unanimously approved.

Meeting ended at 8:26pm.
