# Minutes of Monthly Business Meeting, July 12, 2009

Meeting began 7:22pm.

# Officer's Reports

<u>Chatelaine</u> – Contacts with some people via the Internet, but no one at Newcomer's Night.

Baron & Baroness – We went to an event (Novice Tourney/Challenge of the Heart). No court business at that event except the transfer of the Knight Marshal office. We hope to have the Pennsic baronial court on August 3 at 5:30pm at the Atlantian pavilion on the battlefield. Orla said that Their Majesties would like to get as much business done at the local branch court as possible. The Baron and Baroness also NEED award

recommendations from the populace.

<u>Herald</u> – One badge submission was received at Novice.

Knight Marshal – Fighter practice continues. Would like to take off both weeks of Pennsic. Orla said she doesn't have a problem with that, but she needs to publicize that. Constanza said that at the last fighter practice we had two successful authorizations out of three attempts. No injuries. Looking for someone to cover as marshal for the July 20 fighter practice.

<u>Exchequer</u> – Quarterly report agrees with bank statements but not event reports, but these don't usually match. Trying to contact Abel regarding the St. Aiden's event. Bank gave us \$85 for reasons unknown. Signature card is in the mail. Balance was \$4,046.46 at end of 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter. As soon as she finishes counting cash, she will estimate what the Novice take was.

MoL – Novice report went in on time. We had to redo the check because one fighter failed and we had to make a refund. We had 27 authorizations at Novice.

Seneschal – Coronation will be at Stierbach Baronial Birthday on Aug. 29. At Coronation there will be a "baronial presence" competition. (Discussion ensued on how to make a great entry until Orla recommended it should be discussed later.) We're looking for at least a deputy Minister of Minors and deputies for most other officer positions. Johanna has suggested we consider donating our share of the St. Aiden's proceeds to the Kingdom, either for the Pennsic Children's Fête or the general fund, because the Kingdom is hurting. Tirzah said she would be inclined to support Johanna on this; it would be a nice gesture. Orla tabled this until after Baronial Birthday, when we will have hard

#### **Past Events**

Storvik Novice Tourney and Dun Carraig Challenge of the Heart— (Victoria) Orla noted that the autocrat for Novice was not in attendance. Brenna said she will get her report in this week. Orla said that the event went fairly well as an experiment among outside groups. It was a positive experience with some learning aspects.

Teleri said that \$1,273.68 is the estimated total take from Novice.

# **Upcoming Events**

<u>Post-Pennsic Dessert Revel</u> – (Brenna) Brenna said no one has made reservations yet. The church gave us the use of the kitchen for the entire time at their five-hour price.

<u>August baronial meeting</u> – Orla noted that the traditional barony meeting date for August falls on the last day of Pennsic. Do we need to have an alternate date, such as Sunday, Aug. 16? (Group agreed on Aug. 16.)

<u>Storvik Baronial Birthday</u> – (Kunigunde) Tirzah said that we will be having an English feast. Orla said there are no reservations yet. Indications are that Their Majesties will be in attendance. Orla said that as far as she knows, everything is going well. Rorik said we will have the Baron's Cribbage Tournament, and Teleri is sponsoring the Poeta's Challenge. Orla said to Teleri, "You are the most active Poeta I've ever seen."

#### **Old Business**

<u>Donations</u> – Teleri said that \$370.65 is the unofficial amount of fighter practice donations for May, June and July.

#### **New Business**

<u>Silverware / feast gear</u> – Orla said she has seen Beatrix's nice set of silverware, and the barony does not have any silverware to go with our High Table dishes. She would like to get some. It's a pattern from World Market at an estimated cost of less than \$5 per place setting. This was tabled until August.

<u>Beginner's Ball</u> – Sonja said that she is running the Beginner's Ball at Pennsic and would like to have a small sideboard of food. Would the barony consider sponsoring it? Brenna moved that we spend an amount not to exceed \$110 to sponsor the food at the Beginner's Ball. Seconded by Tirzah. Motion passed unanimously. Tirzah also had menu advice.

<u>Atlantian Royal guards at Pennsic</u> – Janina said that Atlantian Royal now has enough guards so we're off the hook for Pennsic guard duty.

Meeting adjourned at 8:35pm.
