#### Minutes of Monthly Business Meeting, July 18, 2010

Meeting called to order at 7:08pm

Chatelaine - (Tirzah) Two new people are attending the business meeting. A couple of people showed interest in taking the Chatelaine/Castellan position but they did not come to the meeting.

Chronicler - (Kunigunde) June Drekkar is out. Nothing else new.

Baron & Baroness - (Rorik & Janina) Getting ready for Pennsic. They are not having court at Pennsic but may hold margarita night, Tuesday of war week at sundown. At-home in September will be a barbeque and they would like as many people as possible to come. They would like to introduce folks to "Their Nexcellencies". Janina is working on heraldic cloaks to give to the Barony. They will have everything ready to hand over by Investiture. They are trying to get the coronets appraised.

Exchequer - (Teleri) She has \$45 of MOL fees which she needs to deposit. She also needs to submit the changes to Storvik's financial policy to the Kingdom. Second Quarter report is complete. She has noticed intermittent fees of \$11 to the bank account and must research it. She will make a spreadsheet of how much we receive (in donations) for fight practice versus how much it costs.

Herald - (Patricia) Second Quarter report is in. She is working on Atlantian College of Herald newsletters.

Seneschal - (Orla) Sean Delamara is now Knight Marshal and is doing a wonderful job. He is bringing in donations (to help pay for the site).

There will be two meetings at Pennsic - Meet the Board of Directors, Wednesday of war week (right after the Children's Fête) and a meeting with Society Seneschal for exchequers - they are discussing state-based subsidiary groups.

## Events

Post-Pennsic Revel – (Janina) If we don't use the kitchen, the church will drop the price \$50. Since a few members offered generous donations, the site fee will be \$9. Amber is working on a webpage. Janina will send invitations with details to local barons. Janina is requesting \$200 for the cash box. Beverly Mah is doing troll. 80 attendees is the break-even point. Tirzah is reservationist; Stephan will help with decorations. The budget is \$10 for drinks.

Storvik Baronial Birthday & Investiture – (Kunigunde) Discussion of budget and some corrections. Site charge is \$180; camping fees and honoraria lines removed. Break-even attendance is 100 adults and 15 children. Heavy fighter, archery, rapier and A&S champions will all be chosen at this event. Discussion of prizes. Tirzah motions to approve the budget with corrections. Sorcha seconded and it was unanimously approved.

## Old Business

Medallions – Orla has been unable to contact the man who made medallions for the Barony. We should look for medallion-makers at Pennsic.

Moving the storage shed – The shed has been moved and the Seneschal offers thanks to the many people who helped. It took less than four hours to take down, move, and set up the shed and take an inventory. Someone needs to have a third key cut and sent to Tommy because the shed is on his property. Rorik volunteers to do this.

Polling – The polling has gone out. Janina thinks it was difficult to read on red paper. The paper color is chosen by someone at Kingdom level. Orla has given a check to Teleri for \$72.35 for the difference in what was given to her in the advance and what was spent. The original plan was that the announcement would be made the night before Post-Pennsic Revel.

St. Aidan's Melee College event – Teleri needs to send a check to Kingdom for the profit to be shared from St. Aidan's Melee College. The Baron and Baroness have the troll box.

## New Business

Performer's Revel – The Baroness is traditionally the Autocrat for this event.

August meeting – Baronial meeting for August will be cancelled unless something comes up. It would have been scheduled on the last Sunday of Pennsic.

September meeting – Meeting is scheduled for the day after Baronial Birthday.
