The View from the Crowe's Nest

By the time you read this, the holidays are done and we are plowing along in the winter of 2011. Still, I want to say Happy New Year and share such news as I have. December is a quietish month for the SCA here, and that's all to the good...

I couldn't say it yet last month, but we welcomed three Storvikii to the ranks of nobility recently. At Holiday Faire, Her Majesty's Court proceeded to the archery field, where Lady Nuala, Lord Geoffrey and Lord Breccan were given their Awards of Arms. Vivant!

We have three Storvik events on the Kingdom calendar. Performer's Revel is February 19, here in the Barony. Bring a performance piece of any kind to share! Storvik Novice and Unbelt Tourney is June 17-19. I love this event – it's a chance for newer fighters and squires to really shine. Storvik's Baronial Birthday is September 16-18. Mark your calendars now!

I need help with a project near and dear to my heart - making fighter tabards for the heavies and something equivalent and suitable for our If you have an embroidery rapier fighters. pattern for the dragon head (not the sock puppet version) or the whole drekkar, please please please send it to me! I also need help assembling them - that's pretty straightforward hemming or machine-stitching parts that need reinforcement. They absolutely must be finished by the end of February to go to Gulf Wars in March! Is anyone interested in being the point person to create a baronial baldric or something similar for the rapier fighters? Let me know; you'll need to coordinate with Lord Celric, who's been gathering input from the rapier fighters.

Several Storvikii attended Unevent early this month, which was curtailed for a surprisingly heavy snowfall. I saw both Lady Kunigunde our Chronicler and Lady Patricia our Herald there. If you've never been to Unevent, it's the one and only un-garbed gathering all year - a chance for all the martial activities, the Orders, the Peers, the Royalty and Baronage to have a day-long business meeting. It's a great place to catch up on changes to Kingdom Law or Martial rules. The day ends with a Curia, a chance to weigh in on any changes to Kingdom Law. Since Prince Michael and Princess Seonaid are particularly interested in updating Kingdom Law with an eye to clarifying some passages, it was well worth listening to the debate. I also sat in on target archery, scribes, Order of the Pearl, and Royalty-Baronage meetings. You can read in the business meeting notes the reports of various Baronial Officers on the sessions they attended.

Minutes of Monthly Business Meeting, Dec 19, 2010

Officers' Reports

<u>Baron & Baroness</u> - Not much activity. Sorcha went to Unevent. B&B-at-home was small. William passed armoring supplies on to Griffin.

<u>Exchequer</u> - (Teleri) Teleri has been working on creating a new bank account. Wachovia asked for forms that don't exist. No one else seems to be having these problems so Milipitas is faxing forms to another (bank) branch for us. We have to keep using the old account until the new one is set up. It is time for inventories of baronial stuff.

<u>Chronicler</u> - (Kunigunde) November Drekkar is ready to go out but not out yet. Sorcha will write a Crowe's Nest article and email it by Monday. She went to Unevent.

<u>Herald</u> - (Patricia) She went to Unevent. Triton Herald is not worried about her warrant expiring and she may continue as Storvik's Herald if she wants to. William's badge passed. William's daughter is working on her name. Known World Scribal Symposium is coming up. Nuala is hosting a scribal night on Friday, Jan 7.

New events

<u>Golden Rose</u> - We did not get the bid because the Roses do not want the event to be more than six hours' travel from the northernmost Rose or the southernmost Rose. The Baron, considering that

many members have a transportation threshhold, thinks this is despicable. Many Northerners will never be able to go to the Golden Rose Tourney.

<u>Performer's Revel</u> - Sorcha has the budget ready. No site fee is charged, only feast fee. There was a rumor that all attendees must participate in Bardic but Corpora states that making an attempt at pre-1600s garb is required, and no other limitations may be made. Max number for feast is 35. Teleri moves we approve the budget and it is unanimously approved. Teleri says the event budget was supposed to be approved four months before the event. We will consult with the Seneschal and Kingdom Exchequer and ask if we can continue with the event.

<u>Storvik Birthday</u> - (Kunigunde) Date is Sept 18. Joscelin is MIC. Maryland Longship Company would like to bring their longship. Kunigunde will ask Ysende if she wants to run A&S.

<u>St. Aiden's</u> - No Autocrat has come forward to run this event. We will ask Orla to contact them to see if she needs to reserve a date for it.

Orla is asking for checks to Patuxent River Park for Saint Aiden's, Novice Tourney and Storvik Birthday. Sorcha moves that we write a check to Orla for \$1,000. This includes a 10% increase from last year's prices, just in case the price goes up. This is seconded and unanimously approved.

Old business

<u>Medallions</u> - Sorcha is tracking down the medallion maker. The cast for the Lozulet that William had had cracks in it.

Bardic night - Jean-Maire wants people to contact her for the address.

<u>Tabards</u> - Rapier people are working on a baronial symbol for their use. Sorcha has fabric to donate. She has had a request for two kids' tabards. It was noted that these were fairly tall children, so their tabards will not use much less fabric than an adult tabard.

<u>Financial policy</u> - We have been discussing changing the financial policy. Teleri handed out copies. It is also on the website. One issue is last-minute budget changes. We cut down feast for Storvik Birthday in 2010 to 60 seats and there was not an easy way to increase the number since it wasn't in the budget. Tirzah fronted the money and we voted later to reimburse her. William suggests we put the higher amount on the budget and give the cook a lower limit pending more pre-reges. Everyone is encouraged to read the financial policy and be ready to discuss it at the next meeting.

<u>Kingdom 30-Year event</u> - Set at Montpelier. Stierbach is autocratting and renting large pavilions and is requesting pavilions for other things. Siegfried McClure is Autocrat. The Prince and Princess are looking at Kingdom law and asking for feedback.

We need a new Chatelaine.

William would like us to put in a bid for a Kingdom-level fighting event. We would also like to look at holding Unevent or University. Patty suggests we can ask members to check with their churches or schools or other local churches and schools to figure out costs. There is a Kingdom Bid Coordinator if we have questions.
