Minutes of Monthly Business Meeting, Jan 16, 2010

Officers' Reports

Herald - (Patricia) Not much to report. She still needs to do the quarterly and annual reports for the College of Heraldry. She is available to help people with heraldry.

Baron & Baroness – Attended a recent event - Igor Bear and William Shoprat entered A&S; Nuala taught a class; Carlisle won the chess tournament. Devan is interested in being deputy Seneschal, Beverly is interested in being Chatelaine. B&B are going to Ponte Alto Investiture; William is going to Gulf Wars.

MOL - (Stefan) Nothing to report

Exchequer – (Teleri) Unevent for northern Exchequers was yesterday (Jan 15). The new bank account is up. Checks should now be written to "SCA - MD Inc., Barony of

Storvik" for Storvik activities. Teleri had help from Johanna in closing the old bank account and setting up the new one. Notes from Unevent: Autocrats or Seneschal should send in attendance figures with NMS forms for events. If you submit an event bid, be sure you can afford to do what is on the bid - the group needs to have the money in the bank. Questions which have come up include: If something broke, note that in the inventory. Fourth quarter report is complete. Review of books was completed and passed, with the help of old newsletters from the last couple years. Teleri has the new checkbook and deposit slips.

Chronicler – (Kunigunde) Not sure if she got December Drekkar out. Will do it ASAP.

Seneschal – (Orla) has announced that she plans to step down in September. We need a new Seneschal. Whoever steps up should be deputy for a few months and Orla will train them. Regarding the Golden Rose Tourney, Storvik is geographically undesirable.

Teleri pointed out that the Seneschal and Exchequer have to be at the meeting for votes to count. Orla was available by phone. Johanna is the emergency Seneschal's deputy.

Events

Orla went to Croom in January and we were able to get all of our preferred dates, after some negotiation with other people in line. The site fee is \$240 for each of our events, from Friday afternoon to 5pm Sunday. There may be another group setting up in the afternoon while we finish tearing down. Orla will email out contracts to autocrats of our two events.

Performer's Revel – (Sorcha) Budget was in late but it was approved. We have a webpage for it on our site and it is on Spike.

Novice Tourney (Elizabeth is autocrat but did not attend) Orla says all major positions are filled but she is not sure who the cook is.

Storvik Birthday (Kunigunde) Mistress Caitlin will cook. She wants \$10 per person for the feast and \$2.50 to 3.00 for lunch. Kunigunde is still working

on the budget. Teleri says the total amount signed off on is the most we can spend on the event. Sorcha says Bright Hills may be able to help us with budgeting numbers for lunch. Teleri can provide records of past events.

New Business

Financial Policy - There is a question of how to phrase SCA subsidiaries. Teleri will check. Orla suggests replacing 'group' with 'branch'. Financial policy discussion will be tabled until the February meeting to make sure we have the most recent version. Stefan suggests we read other baronies' financial policies for ideas.

Medallions - Orla is in contact with Drogo (Rabenwald Metalsmithing) about medallions. The thought was that it is better to use a company than an individual. Patricia says the description is registered with the Heralds. Orla says the description is registered but the picture is not. It can be done differently as long as it still matches the description. Consensus is that we are not too attached to the current design. Orla says we should get the art together for all the medallions to give to Drogo and Lynette for the bid process. The medallions we need are for Lozulet, Owl, Faering and Selkie. Patricia will get the heraldic descriptions together.

Rubber stamps - Teleri has been waiting for the new bank account to be set up and she will get the new stamps soon.

New Business

Team Wench - Tirzah says Team Wench is a non-profit which puts together a Privateer Feast in March as a fundraiser for a charity for breast cancer. Tirzah is cooking. Sorcha motions that we lend the baronial cooking gear to Team Wench. Patricia seconds and it is unanimously approved. Tirzah will go to the shed and make sure all the pots are returned.

New site for Post-Pennsic Revel - Rorik and Janina were looking for a new site. Teleri suggests the Chronicler keep a list of sites we've looked into. Patricia suggests a database on the Yahoo Group. Kunigunde reminds everyone that we would have to ask Barons and Baronesses of other areas to use land outside of our barony.
