Minutes of Monthly Business Meeting, March 20, 2011

Attendees: Baroness Sorchas Crowe, Orla
Carey, Tirzah MacCradden, Devan
Riley, Teleri the Well-Prepared, Patricia of
Trakai.

The meeting commenced at 7:21 p.m. (the
exact moment of the Vernal Equinox).

Officers' Reports

Herald (Patricia) – A few days ago Patricia was
notified by the Triton Principal Herald that she
has been promoted to Drakkar Pursuivant.
This title is reserved for the baronial herald of
Storvik only with permission from the Triton
Herald. The previous Drakkar Herald was Lord
Pedro de Alcazar. Patricia will inform the
webministers of the change.

Chatelaine - Orla noted that Tirzah's
chatelaine warrant has expired. No word on a
replacement yet.

Seneschal (Orla) - The St. Andrew's church

leaders do not want us to fight outdoors until
after April 18 due to Lenten prayer services.
Baron Sean has been made aware of that.
Mistress Kiri died unexpectedly during the past
week and the memorial service for her will be
next Sunday in the Barony of Dun Carraig. The
Society is in the process of shifting to electronic
Kingdom newsletters by 2012. Orla expects
further cost-saving measures (at the Society
level) down the pike.

B&B (Baroness Sorchas) - It has been a quiet
month. We helped get Baron William ready for
Gulf Wars and sent five new fighter tabards down
there, thanks to the Baronial At-Home attendees.
We still need five or 10 more tabards and need
help with that. There will be a Baronial Brewing
Smackdown at this year's Highland River Melees.
This will be mentioned soon on the Merry Rose.
Trash talk will be intentional.

Exchequer (Teleri) - As of Feb. 28 Storvik has a
balance of \$8,405.94. Teleri just found one \$12
preregistration check for Performers' Revel that
was not deposited. The Performers' Revel event
report is due tonight. Last week several Barony
members got together to review the baronial
financial policy. The Domesday report got sent
back for a minor computer issue, which has been
corrected, so we are OK now.

Event Reports

Performers' Revel - Sorchas said that the event
had 37 attendees but only 14 of them had pre-
registered. The cooks spent about \$100 more
than anticipated in the event budget, which was
\$324 total. One of the receipts for the food was
submitted past the deadline for receipts as listed
in the baronial financial policy.

After some discussion, Tirzah made a motion to
pay \$324 (the total amount of the event budget)
to the cooks and to donate all of the net proceeds
from the event to the Kingdom Travel Fund in the
name of Performers' Revel. Teleri seconded it.
Motion approved unanimously.

Novice Tourney, Storvik Birthday - The autocrats
of Storvik's upcoming events were not present.
