Minutes of Monthly Business Meeting, Sept 19, 2010

Attendees: Kunigunde von Darmstadt, Justus von Ulm, Sorcha Crowe, Tirzah MacCrudden, Orla Carey, Patches, Rorik Fredericsson, Janina Krakowska, William the Younger, Teleri the Well-Prepared, Stefan of Cambion

Meeting called to order at 7:21pm

<u>Chatelaine</u> - (Tirzah) No contact from newcomers but they show up at events. There is a push from Kingdom to try to bring in young people. Tirzah's warrant is expiring soon so we will need a new chatelaine. Kalisa is northern region Chatelaine.

<u>Baron & Baroness</u> - (William & Sorcha) They got invested. William will be attending Coronation and War of the Wings.

<u>Chronicler</u> - (Kunigunde) July and August Drekkars are finished and sent in. Sorcha wants to write a column about the doings of people of Storvik and she is looking for input.

Exchequer - (Teleri) We have money.

<u>MOL</u> - (Stefan) There were 8 adult and 6 youth authorizations/youth upgrades of division at Storvik Baronial Birthday and Investiture.

Seneschal - (Orla) Unevent is in Winston-Salem. Ask someone who's going to take notes for you if you can't go. Crown Tourney is in Leesburg, the first northern-region Crown in a long time. Kingdom Arts & Science Festival is the first weekend of February and Winter University is the first weekend of March - they have changed places. Pennsic 2013 is moving up a week because Cooper's Lake is hosting the Pyrotechnics Guild International annual convention. Amber is interested in being web minister deputy.

Past Events

<u>Beginner's Ball</u> - (Patches) This was wellattended. Storvik donated \$50. Patches did not need as much money as she had thought to increase the amount of food provided. She spent \$76 total.

Post Pennsic Revel - (Janina) The event lost over \$300. A large number of people brought desserts (for a discount) and the cost of the hall has increased. Orla says we need to find a cheaper site by January. There is a push from Kingdom to decrease the number of events. Fewer events should mean better attendance for each event. Storvik's Yule event has been cancelled. Rorik pointed out that the kitchen was not needed for PPR, which saved some money and will let us look for sites without kitchens.

Storvik Baronial Birthday & Investiture - (Kunigunde) Johanna is currently helping the head Troll (Patricia) tally the gate numbers and money, but we had about 70 pre-registrations and at least 200 non-pre-reged attendees. We made money. The archery people were very excited about the event - there were 50 archers and just under 50 heavy combat fighters. William mentioned there were some unexpected expenditures (charcoal) but Kunigunde thinks the purchases were all under budget. It had been decided to increase the feast seats from 60 to 80, with a donation from Tirzah to cover the cost, and the seats sold out.

Old Business

<u>Storvik Medallions</u> - Orla has still not heard from the medallion-maker. We need to find a vendor. The old medallions were pewter. The maker was Treasure Cast.

New Business

<u>Feast</u> - Teleri makes a motion that we reimburse Tirzah for fronting money to expand the SBB feast by 20 people. It cost under \$160, and the costs were recovered. Storvik's current financial policy prevents us from using Baronial funds to expand feast seats. This is seconded and unanimously approved.

<u>Financial Policy</u> - We will be revising the financial policy - think about what changes we want to make. The policy is on the Yahoo group in the Files section.

<u>Demo</u> - Demo at University of Maryland during First Look Fair - It is too late for this year but we could look into it in the future. It would take sponsorship from a student group. Last time we did University, it was sponsored by the History Club.

<u>ACCEPS</u> - Only Ansteorra is allowed to take credit cards for the SCA using the ACCEPS system online. There is a \$1 per ticket surcharge. We would have to set up the Barony to use it. They hold the money until the week before the event. Some details cannot go through ACCEPS such as tent size and group reservations. We need to look into it more.

<u>Golden Rose Tourney</u> - Orla and Tirzah want Storvik to hold the Golden Rose Tourney as a Kingdom-level event. The date is the third Saturday in May. It is thrown by the Roses (former queens). The Autocrat will need to work closely with the Roses. Orla and Tirzah have someone in mind to ask to Autocrat. It is not a large event - approximately 100 people. William moves that we approach potential autocrats about the event. This is seconded and approved with one abstention.

<u>Rubber stamper</u> - Teleri requests that Storvik approve the purchase of a new rubber stamper for baronial checks. Orla moves that Teleri research the cost of two stamps and purchase them if under \$50. This is seconded and unanimously approved.

<u>Baronial coronets</u> - William wants to have the baronial coronets cleaned and appraised for insurance purposes. Teleri makes a motion that the baronial coronets be cleaned and appraised if the cost is under \$150. This is seconded and unanimously approved.

Patches says the dancers now have their own donation can at Monday night practice, since the can held by the Knight Marshal leaves when him before many dancers arrive. This is approved.
