Meeting commenced 7:35

Chronicler – (Kunigunde) November Drekkar  
went out this week.

Exchequer - (Teleri) Went to Unevent; was  
praised for good performance. Needs to collect  
an inventory of Storvik's property. Teleri  
wants to go to the shed to make an inventory  
herself. Tirzah will submit an inventory of  
dishes she has at home. William wants to fix  
the shed at the same time people are going  
for the inventory – early January?

Seneschal – (Devin) (from report emailed in  
advance) Unevent took place 12/03/11. New  
email address will be rolled out for seneschals  
in the summer of 2012. There were some who  
needed clarification on term limits. It was  
reiterated by the Kingdom Seneschal that

there are no term limits for seneschals. Seneschal  
101 will be taught at the next University.  
Seneschal 102 will be taught in Greensboro in  
03/12. The electronic newsletter will also begin  
March 2012. Populace will be informed in the next  
month. In 3-4 years the hope is to move to  
electronic baronial polling.

Further discussion on Kingdom law concerning  
events took place. The 150 mile rule is by road  
not as the crow flies. The preferred location for  
Kingdom event is within borders defined as south  
of I-495 between I-85 and I-95 and north of the  
North Carolina/South Carolina state line, referred  
to as "The Box." It was stated that this does *not*  
mean you can't submit an event bid if you are  
outside of The Box, but it does reduce your  
chances of getting the event. However  
consideration will be given if the site is especially  
beautiful, or the event bid is creative and  
intriguing, per the Kingdom Seneschal.

We met with Lochmere concerning our shared  
venture "The Event Formerly Known As Baronial  
Birthday," aka TEFKABB. Previously discussed  
plans were confirmed. We will have 2012's  
Autocrat, Troll and Exchequer; in essence, the  
money. They will have the feast, MOL and other  
set-up and maintenance. Breakdown and cleanup  
will be a collaborative effort by both Baronies,  
organized by Lochmere. In 2013 TEFKABB roles  
will be reversed. An award will be given every  
year called the Crabby Viking.

In the Seneschals and Exchequer meeting we  
were recognized by the Kingdom Exchequer for  
the timeliness of our reports. (end typed report)

We do relatively well in our meetings, keeping  
them down to an hour. Devin wants us to have  
our reports prepared in advance.

New email addresses for seneschals will be out in  
summer 2012. Devin plans to attend the  
upcoming Seneschal 101 and 102 classes.

Baron & Baroness - (William & Sorcha) – Both  
went to Unevent. The meeting covered a lot of  
what was in the seneschal meeting, and that pre-  
approved event sites are more likely to be chosen  
for kingdom events. Our site, Croom, is on that  
list.

The seneschal of Roxbury Mill has been in touch regarding our misunderstanding and they have 'approved' our use of the archery range they use, if at a different time. A schedule has been set up. We have tried to remove ugly comments from the archive of the Yahoo group (moderated by Kunigunde).

Chatelaine - (Tirzah) Tirzah is not (re)-warranted yet. She is waiting for a response. Devin will make sure it has been submitted.

Herald - (Patricia) She went to Unevent. The Order of Ullr's Bow (new order) went to Kingdom-level heralds for commentary. A change to kingdom law was made at Coronation – all Award of Arms are equal; all Grants of Arms are equal. This will take time to update in the Order of Precedence database.

Patricia took notes at the Chroniclers' meeting at Unevent: They want all newsletters on a central website. The Kingdom Chronicler thinks Acorn cover art would be a good Arts & Sciences challenge. There was some new information regarding photo releases and forms – there is one form for artistic release, and another for photos.

Exchequer - (Teleri) Novice event feast has been reconciled.

MOL - (Stefan) They are changing some MOL table forms, but there is not much else new.

Archery marshal report from the MOL – There is a new category for archery Marshal in Training for minors. They can take the class at 16 or 17 years of age and perform the duties of MiT as long as there is a marshal present.

MoAS - (Johanna) Had two meetings to prepare for a demo (National Geographic). There were 19 volunteers (SCA) at the demo. Devin reported that there were a number of patrons who were interested in joining the SCA; some have been to Pennsic.

### **Old business**

Croom site reservations – We must go on January 3<sup>rd</sup> to reserve the site for our events.

### **New business**

Carpet at fight practice – William says that the carpet previously used for fight practice at St. Andrew's has been found, but the non-slip pad is missing. This leaves the carpet too dangerous to use. Teleri moves that we allocate up to \$100 to purchase a new non-slip pad. This was seconded and unanimously approved.

Business/calling cards – Devin will cover the cost of paper stock and Mike will print new cards. We need more baronial cards and cards for the Chatelaine as well. Devin moves that we allocate \$65 for new cards and that we find a new printer.

### **Events**

National Geographic demo – (Devin was autocrat) 300 patrons came through. Tirzah made a wonderful soup to share. We have a new sign courtesy National Geographic that says "SCA", the mission statement, and "hosted by Barony of Storvik", thanks to Aaradyn.

Novice – Carlyle volunteered for Marshal in Charge.

The Event Formerly Known As Baronial Birthday (TEFKABB) – (Kunigunde is autocrat) Devin says a group met with people from Lochmere and the exchequers from the two baronies talked. We will supply Exchequer. Troll, Autocrat and Marshal in Charge this year. Tirzah will be reservationist. There will be an award called "the Crabby Viking". We're posting a request for suggestions to name the event. Devin suggests that we set up an online group for the two baronies to work together on the event. Kunigunde will set up a Google group for discussion.

Sorcha motioned we allocate \$1,000 to Croom for deposits for all of our events in 2012. This was seconded and unanimously approved.

Meeting adjourned 8:16pm

Meeting resumed 8:28pm

Since some officers cannot attend the January meeting held on Jan 15, Sorchu moved that we move the meeting to the 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday (Jan 22), to be held at Devin's house. This was seconded and unanimously approved.
