Minutes of Monthly Business Meeting July 17, 2011

Meeting called to order 7:19

Officers' Reports

Baron & Baroness – William and Sorcha went to Stierbach Baronial Birthday. They have been discussing posting their Pennsic schedule.

Chronicler – (Kunigunde) She is up to date on publishing and mailing the Drekkar. Nothing to report.

Web minister - (Aaradyn) She is updating the website, trying to make sure all the information is current. Email or call her with updates. She is redesigning the webpage

based on Atlantian and SCA requirements.

Herald - (Patricia) She went to Known World Heraldic Symposium. She still has to do the royal court report for Novice Tourney. She will do Herald's night at fight practice tomorrow (7/18/11). There is also Herald's Point at Pennsic for anyone wishing to consult a herald.

Seneschal - (Orla) Atlantia's 30 Year Celebration is coming up. They want to display a history of Atlantia, which includes Storvik. If anyone has information or items to share, contact Stefan of Cambion. Orla is stepping down as Seneschal in September at Storvik Birthday. If the new seneschal takes the class at October University, that will be okay. Devan volunteered to be Seneschal and the vote was a unanimous yea.

Orla has been trying to get Ysende to sign the warrant and will keep trying to get in touch with her to see if she wants to be the A&S officer. Orla will call Ysende and we will vote at the next meeting (August 21). Johanna is also willing to be Minister of Arts and Sciences. There will be a quarterly A&S report due in September. Orla wants to change the philosophy that officers don't have to attend barony meetings.

Exchequer - (Teleri) The draft for the second quarterly report is done. She is still working on Novice Tourney reports which may change this report. The bank ledger stands at \$10,322.69. We received about \$3700 from Novice Tourney. There were fewer bank charges than expected.

MOL - (Kunigunde) She is doing one authorization renewal by mail and will need a check.

Events

Novice Tourney – (Elizabeth) The event is over and we made money. Elizabeth will give road and parking signs to Kunigunde for the next event. The new setup worked well and she heard positive things. Everything came in under budget.

The archers didn't supply receipts for archery supplies and targets, and are not available right now. Kingdom said we can separate the archery budget from the event budget. We will vote for reimbursement at the next meeting when they bring receipts.

Elizabeth wants to do a Spring Crown at Croom, which is the first weekend in May.

Storvik Baronial Birthday – (Kunigunde) Nothing new to report. August 21st is the last meeting before the event, so she needs to have check requests in by then. Aaradyn will be doing the map for the fighting. Kunigunde will follow up with Fred about the Longship Company attending with a boat. Teleri needs to talk to the Kingdom Exchequer before we set up ACCEPS. Tirzah will set up ACCEPS. (7/18/11 update, Kunigunde will set up ACCEPS.)

Old Business

Medallions – send pictures of the old medallions to Orla. Patricia will draw the Faering. Orla will send pictures to Elizabeth to forward to the maker.

Possibly dangerous people at our events – The advice of the Kingdom Seneschal was that the Barony Seneschal must first talk with the Kingdom Seneschal, and with their permission can talk to the individual if they are a non-member and tell them they are not a good fit with the SCA. The Barony Seneschal must be the first person to discuss this with the individual; after that, if the Seneschal is not available, the head of the activity (eg. Knight Marshal or Autocrat) may ask the person to leave. They should discuss this with the Seneschal. The SCA is a private organization and we are legally permitted to ask non-members to leave. Johanna pointed out that we still each have our civil liberties; you can tell the individual that they make you uncomfortable and ask them not to be near you.

New Business

Beginner's Ball at Pennsic – Patches is running the Beginner's Ball and is requesting a donation from Storvik. The budget is \$91.00. William moves that we donate \$91.00 to sponsor the ball. Devan proposes that we donate up to \$100 pending receipts from Patches after the Ball. This was seconded and unanimously passed.

Post-Pennsic Revel – Patricia notes that Storvik will not be holding the Post-Pennsic Revel this year. Is Storvik opposed to have an event hosted at someone's house? Orla says that this could be done. It was discussed that it could be an activity rather than an event and could be a potluck dinner/dessert. Last Post-Pennsic cost Storvik \$1,000 and that was too much. If it could be done much more cheaply, we can revisit it. Teleri will look up whether we can charge a fee for an activity which is not an official event.

Children's Toy Chest – Sorcha asked if she can shop at Pennsic to find more period toys for the baronial toy chest. Johanna suggests some places to shop. Sorcha requested \$50 for toys. Tirzah made a motion that we give Sorcha \$50 to buy toys for the baronial toy chest. This was seconded and passed.

Meeting adjourned at 8:11pm.
