Minutes of the Monthly Business Meeting, March 16, 2014

Attendees: Orla Carey, Tirzah MacCruden, Badouin MacKenzie, Rayhanna bint Yusuf, Grazia Morgano, Griele vanden Burgh, Emma West, Johanna von Sudeborn, Teleri the Well-Prepared

Meeting commenced 7:08pm

Officers' Reports

Seneschal (Rayhana): Working on handouts for A&S classes to be taught at the Comfort Inn prior to barony meetings (4-7pm, 3rd Sunday).

Will be largess classes - items suitable for donation to royal largess baskets. Donation of items made in A&S class will be optional, not mandatory.

Chatelaine (Emma): Proposed AwesomeCon demo would cost \$450 for the table. Access to electricity unknown. Tirzah reports that Kingdom Exchequer says baronial funds cannot be used to pay the admission of barony members crewing the table. Rayhana suggests doing a fundraiser to support attending next year. Orla requests Storvikii attending this year scout the site. Grazia points out that InverventionCon is coming up and vendor tables are only \$50. Teleri moves that we approve up to \$200 to be spent on promotional stationary (business cards and postcards) for the barony. Griele seconds. Motion passes unanimously. Emma needs art and a QR code for the stationary, and needs Webminister to set up a "landing page" for the QR code to lead to track traffic.

Contacted by Justin of Funk Parade DC. Funk Parade is a dance parade, May 3, 2014, 5-7pm in the U St neighborhood. Storvik is invited to attend for free. No swordplay or fire, we can hand out business cards. Dancers asked to support.

Monthly newcomers' meetings are open to all; bring projects. Next meeting March 28 at Grazia's house. April, Patches; June, Orla; July, no meeting; August, Emma. Volunteer needed for May meeting; Ruby Joust suggested and the idea is well-liked.

Exchequer (Tirzah): Will go to bank Tuesday and get statement, turn in signature card. Approximately \$9,000 in account. Just paid 2nd quarter practice hall, plus rental for baronial meeting space, so ~\$900 in expenses to be debited from that account. But there should be no other large expenses until June. 1st quarter report will be done when March statement in-hand; Deputy Exchequer will assist

Chronicler (Teleri reporting for Kunigunde): Kunigunde unable to attend meeting. Teleri brought warrant form to get signed, will turn in to Kingdom.

MoL (Kunigunde): Nothing to report

Herald (Patricia via email): Attended Northern Regional Heraldic Commentary meeting

Webminister (Grazia): Will create new page for QR code to land on and add Google Analytics to measure traffic. Rayhana requests Emma (in charge of Facebook page for barony) ensures information on Yahoo! Group makes it on to Facebook. Baron Bedouin notes that managing Yahoo Group, Google Calendar and Facebook is challenging.

Baron and Baroness: There will be a baronial encampment at Ruby Joust.

Badouin priced equipment for improving Storvik's physical plant with heated showers and a sink. He priced a 12x12 pop-up (for two stalls) at \$150 (without walls); sink with faucet, \$100; water heater, \$120 on sale, \$150 regular; assorted hardware, \$50-\$100. Tirzah moves to approve up to \$600 to acquire stall, sink, heater and hardware supplies for barony. Johanna seconds. Motion passes unanimously.

Griele contacted by organizer for Atlantian Children's Fete at Pennsic. Asked to sponsor an activity or sponsor a castle bounce (\$350); prefers A&S activity. Will consult Facebook hivemind for ideas.

Donations for a small gift basket for Coronation are sought. Recommendations for baronial awards are sought.

Novice Tournament (Kunigunde): Autocrat not at meeting. Tirzah says 90% chance we have Marietta Mansion site. Rayhana wants to see entire budget to vote on it, over email if necessary to make deadlines.

Pennsic (Emma): Proposes a Storvik Women's Coffee Day at Inner Vagabond the first Monday of War since there is no Storvik camp. Johanna volunteers to host at her camp. Griele says a social is planned following baronial court at Pennsic as well.

Battle on the Bay (Rayhana reporting for Graciela): Graciela attended meeting in Lochmere, working on getting staff.
